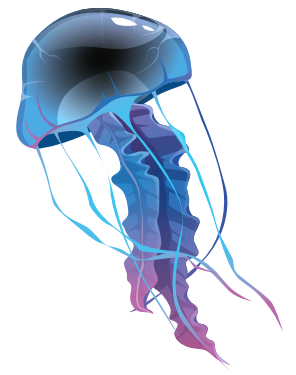


Tube Jellyfish



Materials:

- Ziplock bag
- 3-inch styrofoam ball (cut in half and this will do two)
- Toilet paper roll or ½ of a towel roll
- Light blue acrylic craft paint
- Ivory/cream paint
- Green paint
- 2 googly eyes
- 1 4" pipe cleaner

Staple Supplies:

- Scissors
- Paintbrush
- Craft glue
- Pencil

Instructions

1. Paint the half of styrofoam ball with the light blue paint and allow it to dry.
2. Paint the inside of the cardboard tube first, with ivory, once that's dry paint stripes on the outside of the tube with all three colors.
3. When everything is dry, turn the foam ball upside down with the flat side facing up.
4. Place the tube in the center and "draw" around the tube with the pencil.
5. Remove the tube temporarily and widen the circle, insert the tube into it, fitting it snugly.
6. Use scissors to cut slits up the length of the tube.
7. Bend the tentacles of the jellyfish by pushing the ends of the tube into your palm.
8. Bend the pipe cleaner to create a loop and twist the open ends together.
9. Insert those ends into the top of the jellyfish's head to make a hanger.
10. Glue googly eyes on the front of the half-ball.
