

## Tube Lellyfish





## Materials:

- Ziplock bag
- 3-inch styrofoam ball (cut in half and this will do two)
- Toilet paper roll or ½ of a towel roll
- Light blue acrylic craft paint
- Ivory/cream paint
- Green paint
- 2 googly eyes
- 1 4" pipe cleaner

## **Staple Supplies:**

- Scissors
- Paintbrush
- Craft glue
- Pencil

## Instructions

- 1. Paint the half of styrofoam ball with the light blue paint and allow it to dry.
- 2. Paint the inside of the cardboard tube first, with ivory, once that's dry paint stripes on the outside of the tube with all three colors.
- 3. When everything is dry, turn the foam ball upside down with the flat side facing up.
- 4. Place the tube in the center and "draw" around the tube with the pencil.
- 5. Remove the tube temporarily and widen the circle, insert the tube into it, fitting it snugly.
- 6. Use scissors to cut slits up the length of the tube.
- 7. Bend the tentacles of the jellyfish by pushing the ends of the tube into your palm.
- 8. Bend the pipe cleaner to create a loop and twist the open ends together.
- 9. Insert those ends into the top of the jellyfish's head to make a hanger.
- 10. Glue googly eyes on the front of the half-ball.
