FUNKY COSMIC SUN CATCHERS

MATERIALS:

- White Glue and lots of it!
- Food Coloring or Liquid Watercolors
- Toothpicks
- Plastic lids (Lids from tubs of yogurt, hummus, sour cream etc. work best, although metal lids also work)
- Hole Punch
- String or colorful yarn



Step One: Pour a generous amount of glue into one of your plastic lids and swish it around to cover the entire inner surface.

Step Two: Put one or two drops of each color of food coloring around the glue.

Step Three: Use a toothpick to swirl the colors around in the glue. Stop swirling before the colors get too combined or the final result will be muddy and brown. This is an exercise in restraint!

Step Four: Let dry. As the colors settle they will continue to expand and create a dyed psychedelic effect....I love the 60s... Depending on how much glue you used, the suncatcher will take one to three days to fully dry. You will know it's ready when the edges start to peel off the lid.

Step Five: When fully dry, peel the suncatcher off the lid, punch a hole through the top, add a string or yarn, and hang in a sunny spot.
