_____ The first Elvis movie. At the end of the Civil War, a Confederate team is ordered to rob a Union payroll train but the war ends leaving these men with their Union loot, until the Feds come looking for it.

_____ Elvis' second movie and his first in color was this movie. He played the role of Deke Rivers, a truck driver trying to become the next singing sensation.

_____ His third movie was written by Nedrick Young. Elvis played Vince Everett and was sent to prison after being convicted of manslaughter.

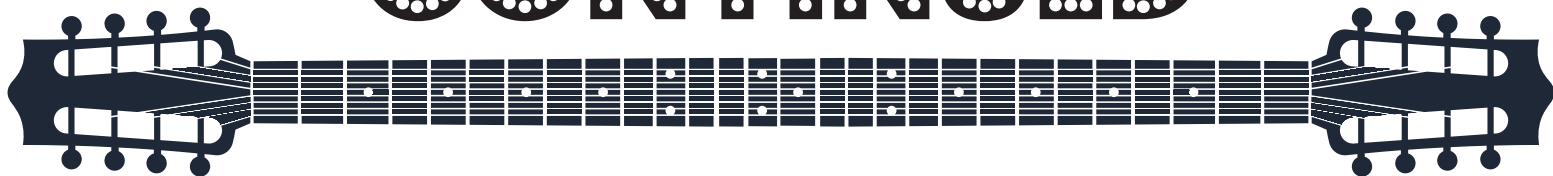
_____ Presley's most critically acclaimed performance as an actor was in this film from 1958. The story is based on a novel by Harold Robbins A Stone for Danny Fisher. Elvis plays Danny Fisher, a rebellious young man who takes a job as a nightclub singer to make ends meet, but he attracts the attention of a local crime boss.

_____ This movie was released in 1960 after Elvis served two years of active duty in the US Army. This was his first musical comedy, playing Tulsa MacLean, an Army sergeant stationed in West Germany. Tulsa, a soldier with dreams of running his own nightclub, places a bet with his friend Dynamite that he can win the heart of an untouchable dancer.

_____ Elvis' sixth movie was a serious movie not just displaying him as a singer and his songs. Elvis plays the son of an Indian mother and a white father. When fighting breaks out between two cultures in West Texas, the mixed-blood Pacer tries to act as a peacemaker, but he gets pulled irrevocably into the deadly violence.

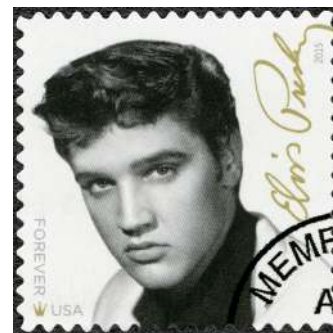

_____ In his seventh movie Elvis plays the young rebel Glenn Tyloer. After a fight with his drunk brother, who is badly injured, his father rejects him. Glenn is put under care of his uncle by a court. He discovers that he has a knack for writing when a counselor encourages him to pursue a literary career.

_____ The eighth file was filmed in a tropical paradise. His biggest commercial success. With 14 songs, the soundtrack album spent 79 weeks on Billboard's pop chart and 20 of those weeks were at #1. This musical comedy starred Elvis as Chad Gates, whose wealthy family owned a pineapple plantation.

_____ Number nine opened on May 23, 1962 and peaked at #5 on the Variety Box Office Survey. This movie was the story of the Kwimper family, who homesteaded on land along a newly built highway in Florida. Elvis played Toby Kwimper. The family opens a small business renting fishing equipment. Gamblers attempt to take advantage of the Kwimpers' trusting nature.

_____ Elvis' tenth movie was a remake of the same title which starred Edward G. Robinson and Humphrey Bogart. Elvis plays a boxer, Walter Gulick and takes a job as a sparring partner at a gym, the owner of which sees potential in Walter as a professional fighter and takes him under his wing.
