APPLE CRAFT



Create your own cards to wish a Happy New Year to your friends who are celebrating Rosh Hashanah!

WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

- Apples
- Forks
- Paper Plates
- Acrylic Paint
- Fine-tipped Markers
- Heavy Cardstock

-  Fold cardstock piece in half from the middle, or cut sheet in half and fold one piece in half to create a card.
-  Cut apples in half in any way, but if you cut them horizontally, you will get a star from the seed pod.
-  Use fork as a handle by sticking it in the back of the apple half.
-  Spread paint out on paper plate. Lightly dip the apple face-down like you would a stamp, then “stamp” it on your card.
-  Let paint dry.
-  Once paint is dry, use markers to add stems and leaves, or embellish as you wish. Add greetings such as “Shanah Tova!” or “Happy New Year!”
