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DID YOU KNOW? Why Tennis Balls are Yellow

Color television became popular in the 1970s, and many people upgraded their TV sets. To make tennis more visible on TV, neonyellow balls were introduced in 1972. The International Tennis Federation found the bright shade of yellow made it easier for viewers to follow. Wimbledon, the oldest tennis tournament, didn't switch to yellow for another 14 years, despite being broadcast in color since 1967.
