Sarsaparilla is a fragrant flavoring derived from the roots of tropical vines belonging to the lily family. It was once a widely sought-after tonic, but today it is predominantly used as a flavoring agent to mask the taste of medications. When blended with wintergreen and other flavors, it is particularly popular in root beer. Sarsaparilla plants, which derive from the Spanish words zarza (meaning "bramble") and parrilla (meaning "little vine"), are indigenous to the southern and western coasts of Mexico through Peru.

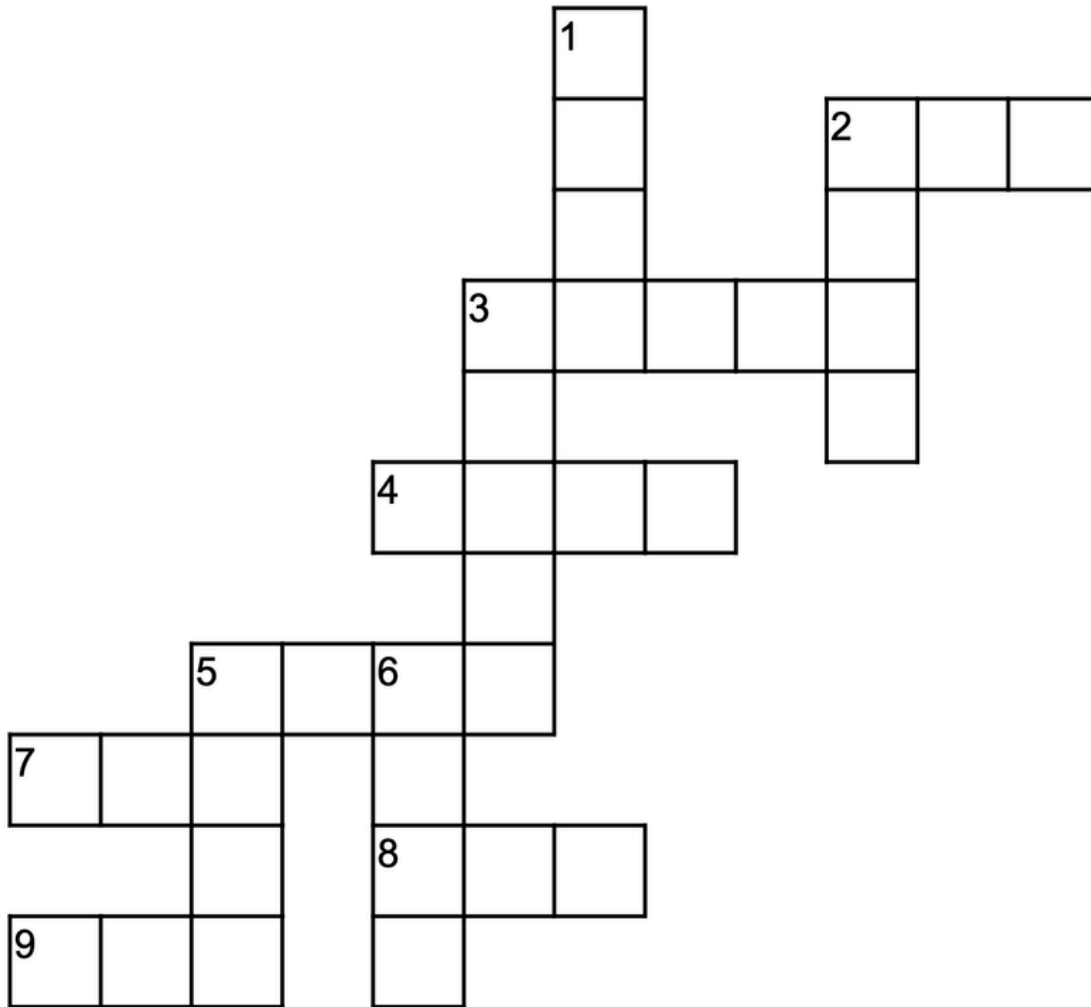

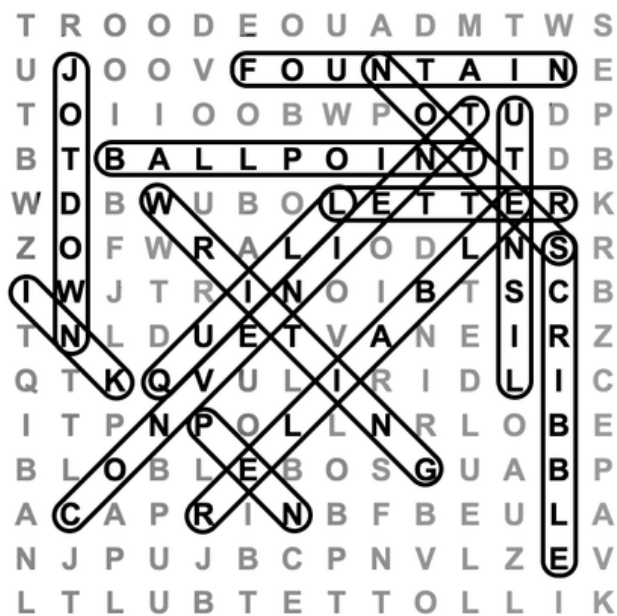

They were placed in a basket and put into the Tiber River, left to die from exposure in the outdoors. Their basket washed up on the river bank where they were found by a female wolf.

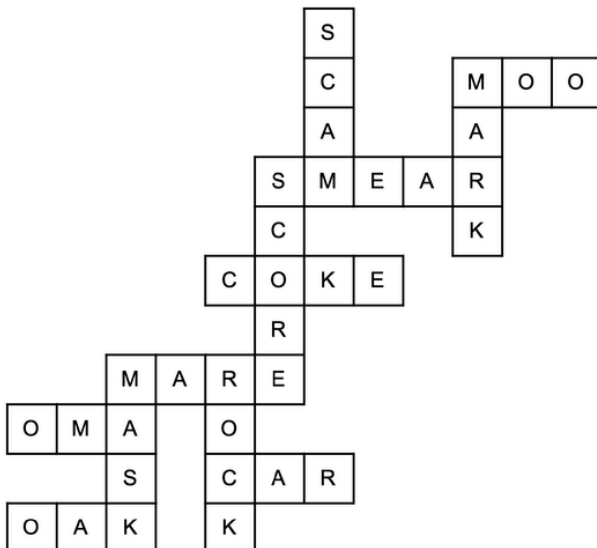
