The Bird of Paradise, an Atlantic-Fokker C-2 manned by the duo of U.S. Army Air Corps Lieutenant Lester Maitland and Lieutenant Alber Hegenberger, flew from Oakland, California, to Hawaii. The flight clocked in at 25 hours and 50 minutes and covered 2400 miles, all without the modern luxuries we enjoy today.

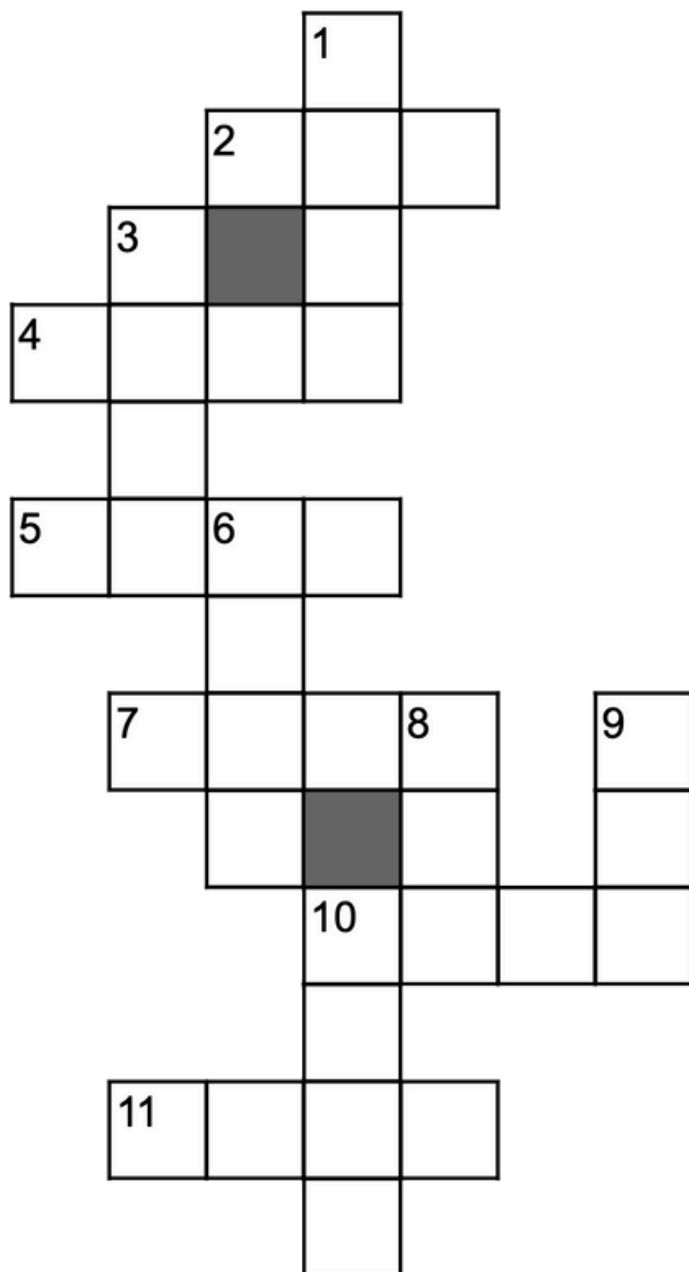

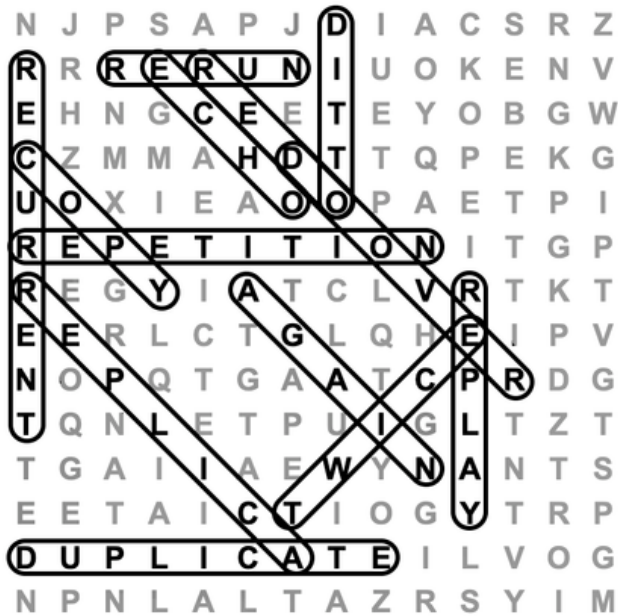

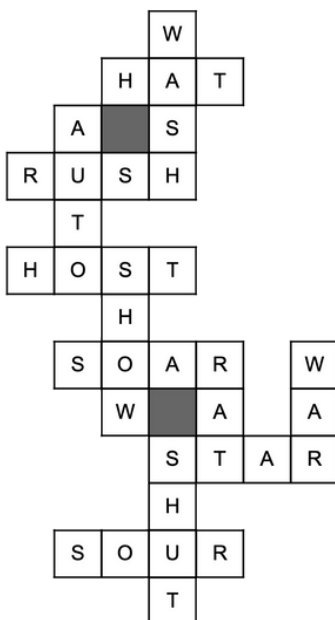
