

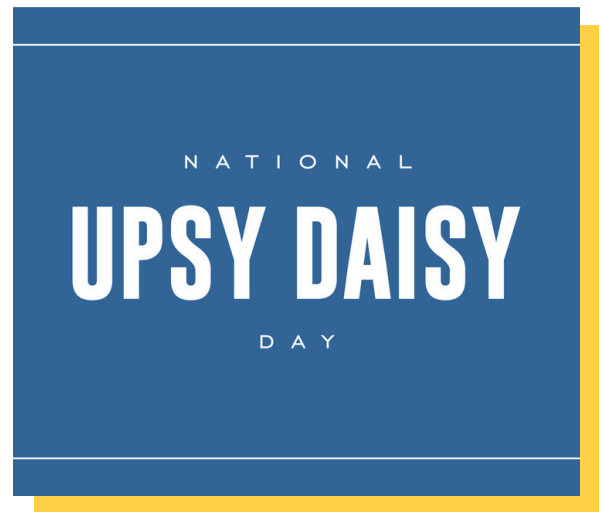

A Talent that Left Too Soon

Israel Kamakawiwoʻe was a native Hawaiian ukulele player, and activist known as the "Voice of Hawaii." He recorded an emotional version of "Somewhere Over the Rainbow" in a single take. He was 6'2" and weighed over 1,000 pounds when he died from respiratory failure. "I'm not scared for myself to die," he once said. "Because we are Hawaiians, we live in both worlds. 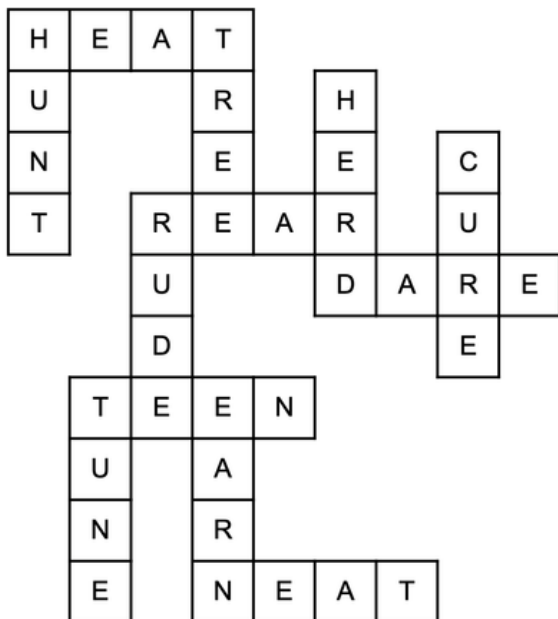
Trivia Answer: A. Reverse
