## Cave and Karst Day

Explorers love June 6th because it is Caves and Karst Day! Founded in 2017 in the United States, the purpose of this day is to highlight the wonders of nature found in caves. Caves offer exciting exploration opportunities, full of diverse plant and wildlife species. Are you unsure what a “Karst” is? Due to erosion in different types of rock like limestone, landscape changes result in towers, ridges, sinkholes, fissures, and other landforms. The changes in topography are karsts. Some of the best-known caves in the United States are Mammoth Cave in Missouri, Antelope Canyon in Arizona which features a brightly colored slot cave, and Carlsbad Caverns in New Mexico, boasting more than 100 caves. Tennessee has over 10,000 subterranean caves ripe for exploration, featuring waterfalls, underground lakes, and amazing land formations.

## DID YOU KNOW? Not in the Kitchen Anymore

Before commercial butter production, people made butter at home by churning cream. The most commonly used household butter churn was the hand-crank butter churn, introduced in the mid-19th century and remained in use until the 1940s. The Dazey Churn & Manufacturing Company introduced glass churns in the early 20th century, which could make smaller quantities of butter much faster than the larger, time-intensive churns. After churning, butter could be poured or pressed into decorative molds for serving.
