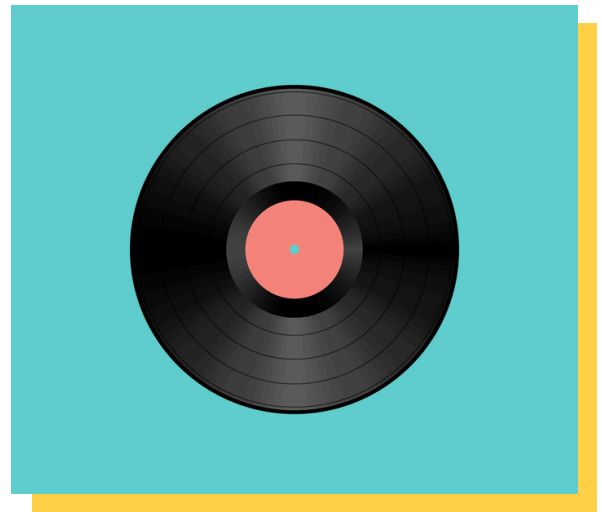

Bruce Springsteen Day

According to many critics, the Bruce Springsteen album “Born in the USA” is one of the best albums ever recorded. The Boss, as Springsteen is known, released this masterful musical collection of songs on June 4th, 1984. It’s sold over 30 million copies worldwide, featuring such songs as “Dancing in the Dark,” “Glory Days,” “I’m On Fire,” “My Hometown,” and, of course, the title song “Born in the USA.” Nominated for the Grammy Album of the Year, Springsteen’s “Born in the USA” went up against some other powerhouse albums, including David Bowie’s “Let’s Dance,” Cyndi Lauper’s “She’s So Unusual,” Prince’s “Purple Rain,” and Tina Turner’s “Private Dancer.” All these amazing artists lost out to Lionel Richie’s “Can’t Slow Down,” the winner of the Grammy Album of the Year.

In 1896, Henry Ford took his first Ford through the streets of Detroit. He introduced the world’s first mass-produced car in 1908. It was the Model Ford. That vehicle sold 15 million units. Ford is also credited with establishing the minimum wage of \$5 in 1914, from a daily rate of \$2.34.

Remember the show “I’ve Got a Secret”? A guest in 1956 at the age of 96, Samuel J. Seymour told the audience that he witnessed the assassination of President Abraham Lincoln. In 1865, when he was 5, his nurse and godmother took him to see Our American Cousin at Ford’s Theatre. He sat in the seats across from the Presidential Box and witnessed the event. He was one of about 1500 people present.
