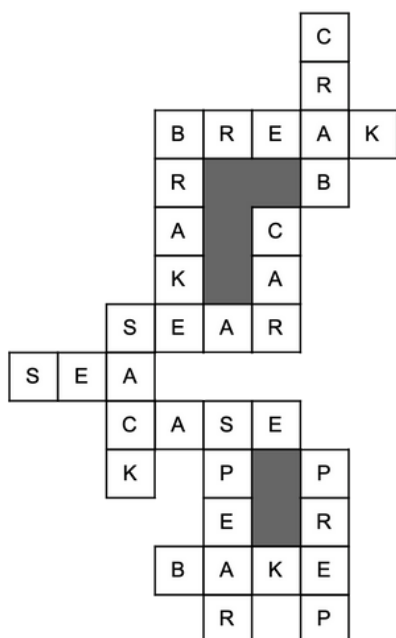
Trivia Answer: A
