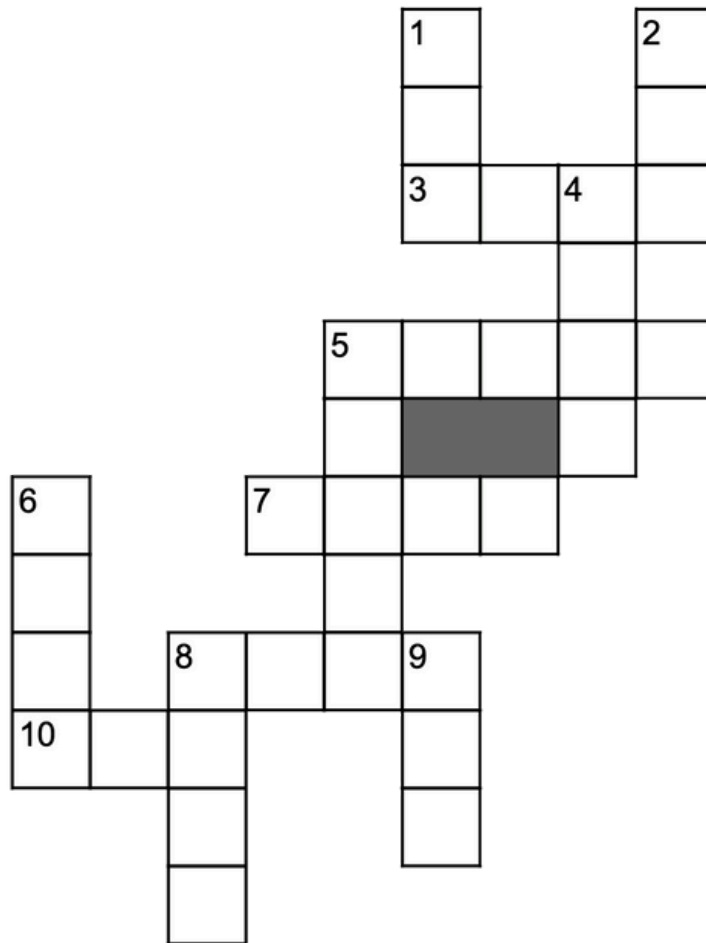

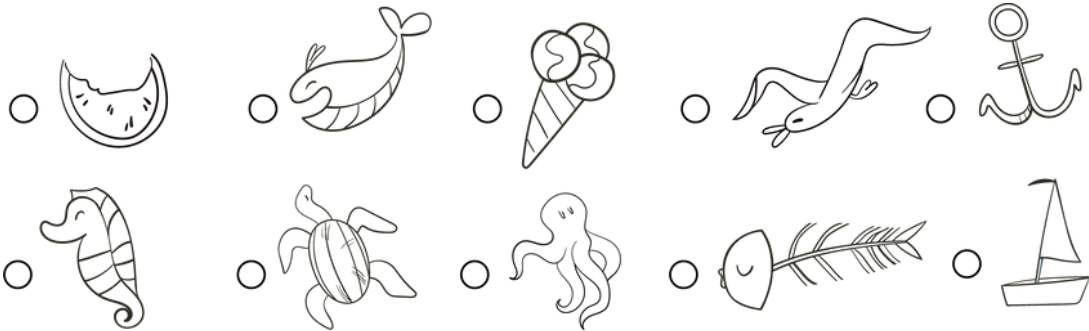

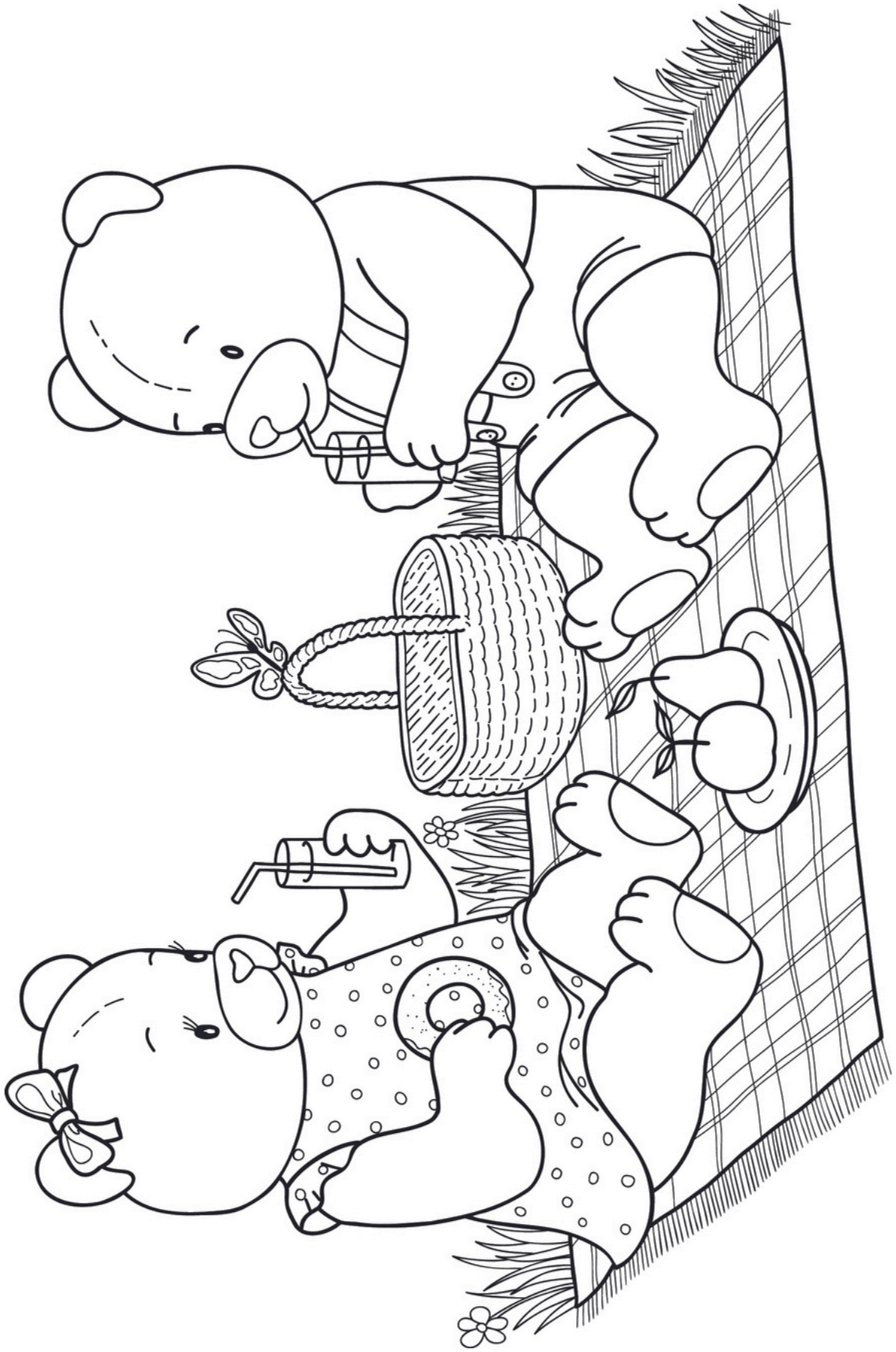

Find the hidden objects in the picture.

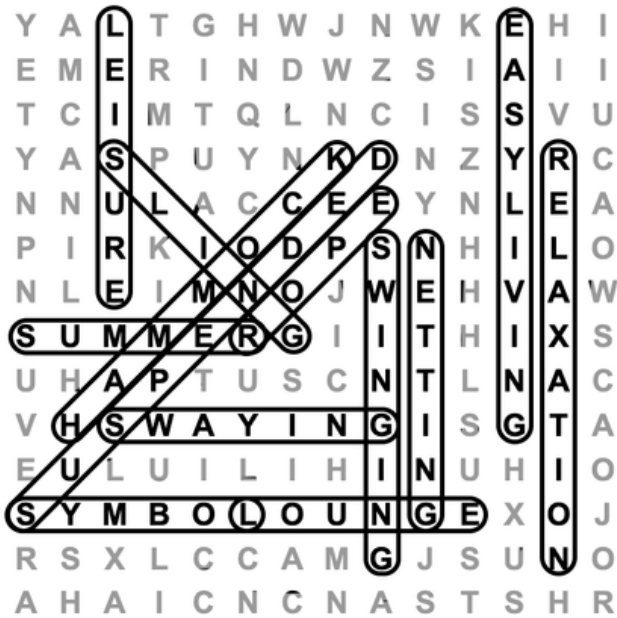
