Today in History



In 1984, Tina Turner had her first #1 hit as a solo artist with “What’s Love Got to Do With It”. She won 8 Grammy Awards and was dubbed the “Queen of Rock and Roll.” Turner was inducted into the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame twice, in 1991 with Ike and in 2021 as a solo artist.

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DID YOU KNOW? Tomato Soup Cake

The earliest recipe for tomato soup cake dates back to 1922; the dessert was popular among Irish immigrants in New England. The recipe yielded a moist red-orange cake that doesn't taste like tomatoes, thanks to the cinnamon, cloves, and nutmeg in the mix. This unusual spice cake was popular through the 1930s and 1940s when wartime shortages called for culinary creativity. In 1960, Campbell Soup Company printed a version on its tomato soup label—the first recipe on a soup can.

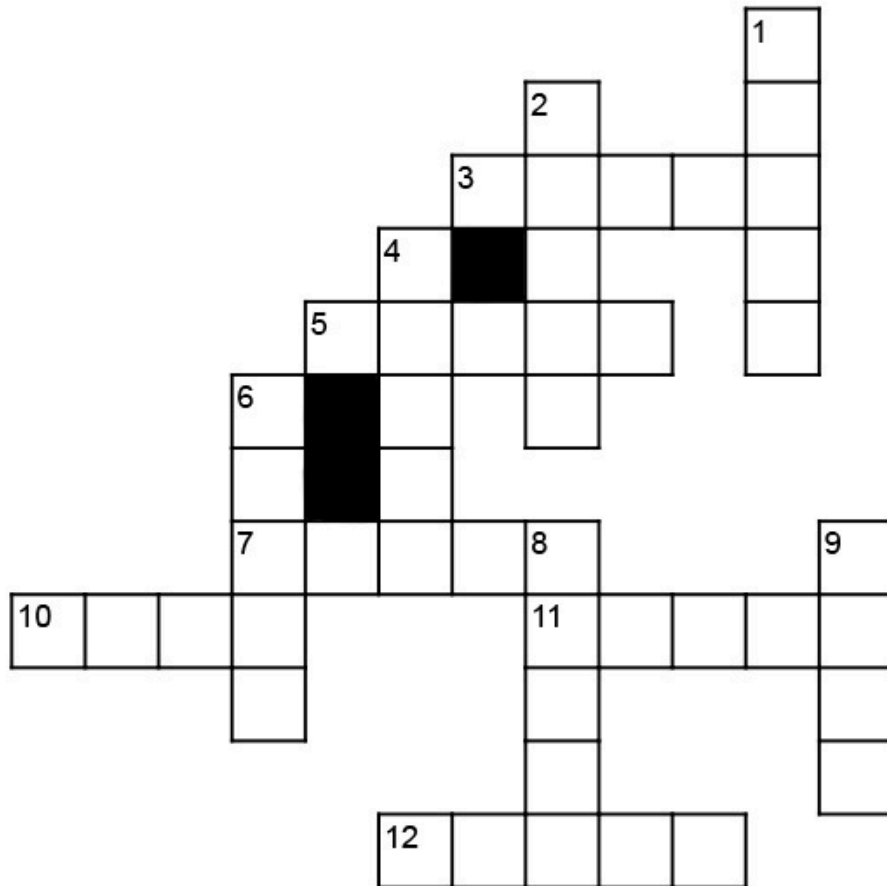

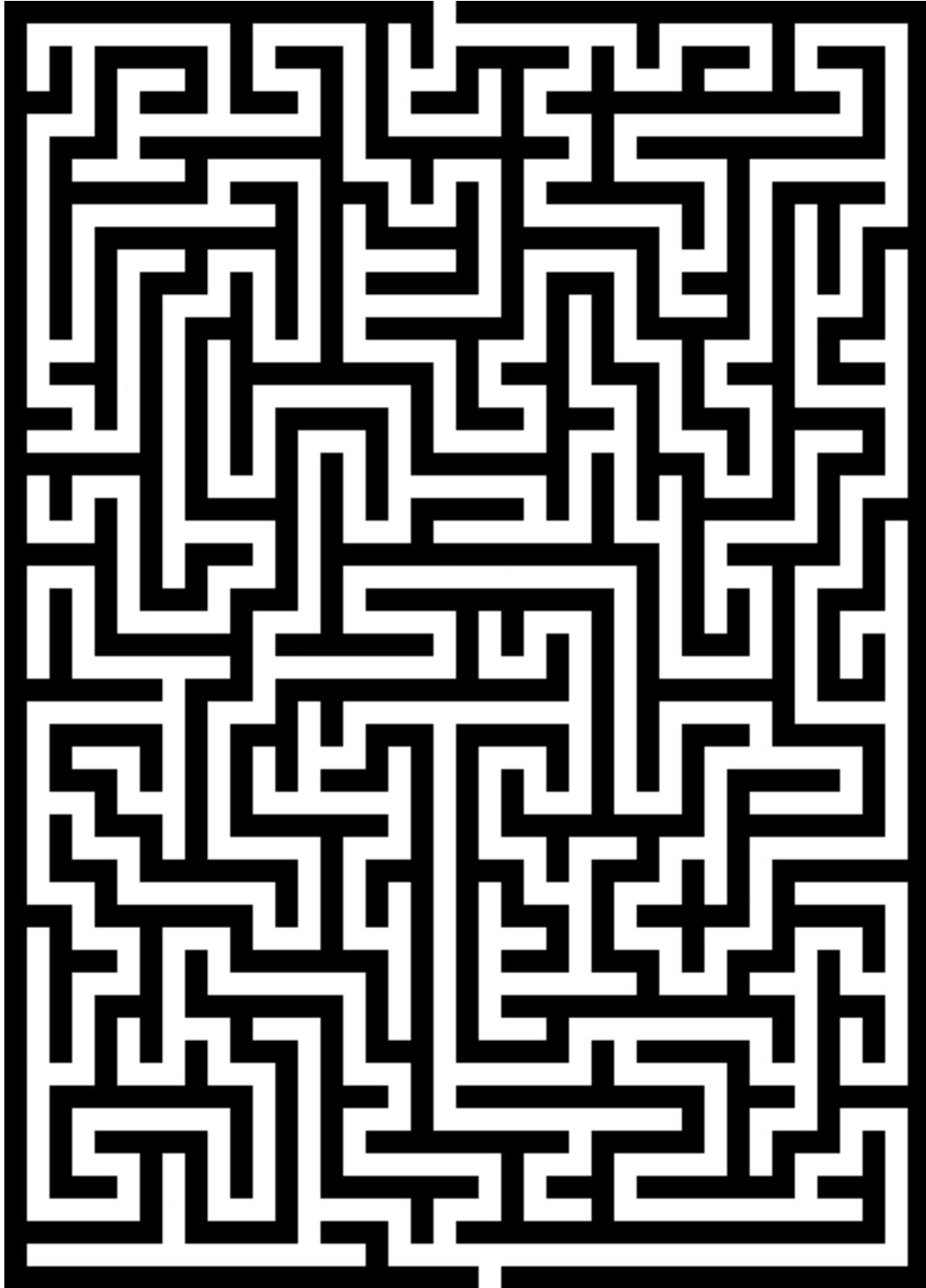

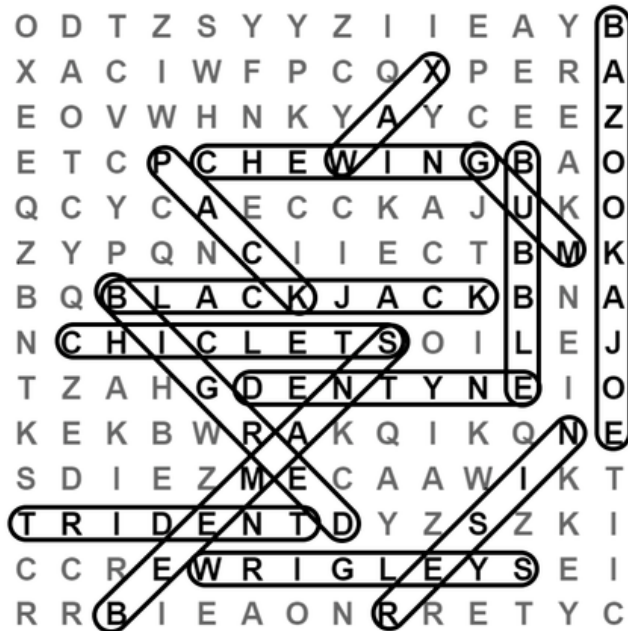




SOLUTIONS
