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


DID YOU KNOW? Herbs & Spices Aren't the Same

The terms "herbs" and "spices" are often used interchangeably, but there is a difference between the two. Herbs come from the leaves of herbaceous plants, which are those that don't have woody stalks. Spices also come from plants, but can be harvested from any part, including the roots, bark, fruit, or seeds. For example, mint leaf is an herb, while cumin seed is a spice. Although salt is often found next to cinnamon and oregano in the grocery store, or stored with other spices, it's actually a mineral.
