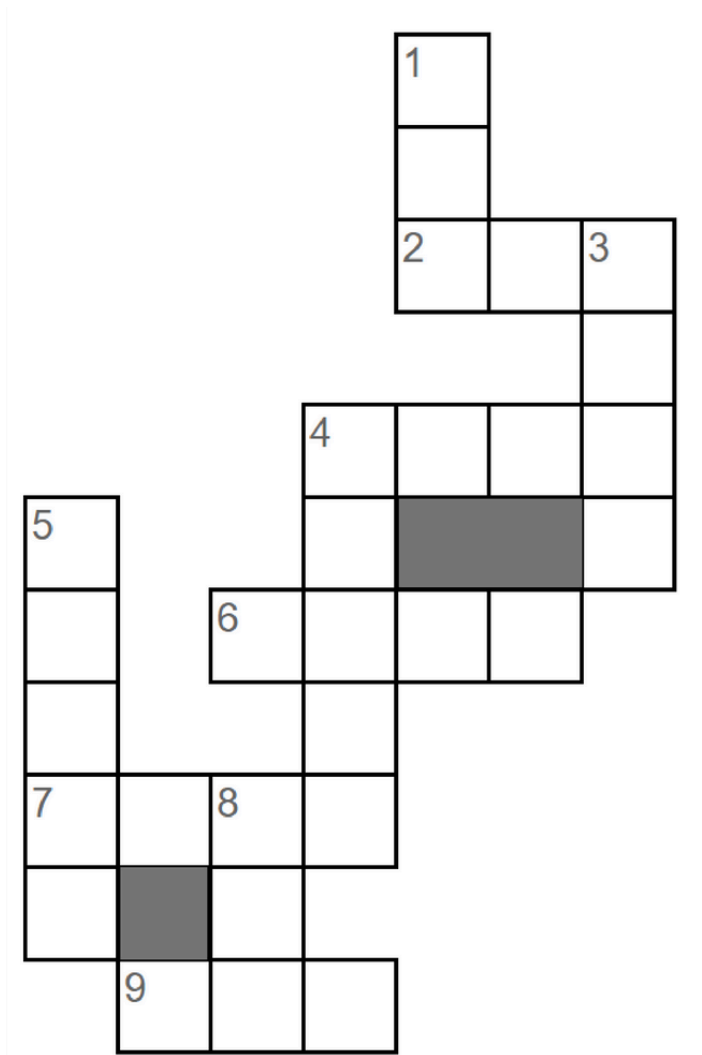
Helpful Tip:

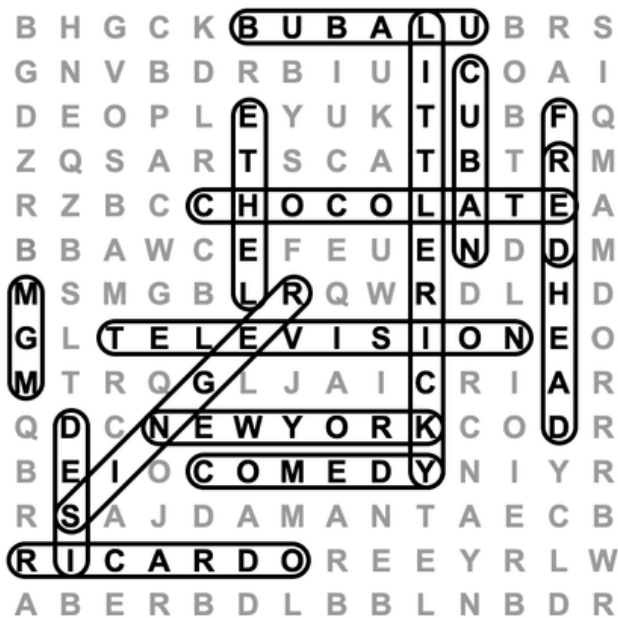

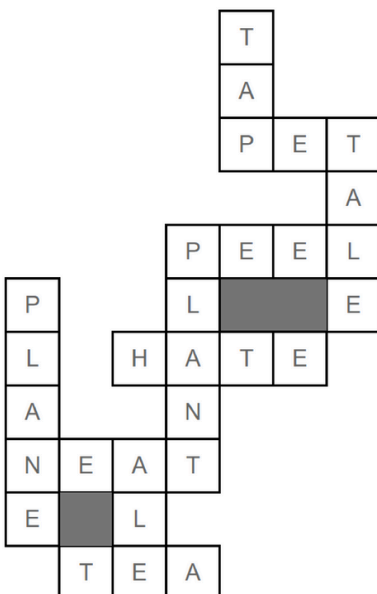
Trivia Answer: D
