## DID YOU KNOW? Frigatebirds Sleep While Flying

Galapagos Island-nesting frigatebirds can sleep while flying, usually in short bursts of about 10 seconds each, for a total of about 45 minutes per day. They can sleep with one hemisphere of their brain at a time, or both together, and their sleep is more asymmetric in flight than on land. They can literally sleep with one eye open, but sometimes they don't even need that.

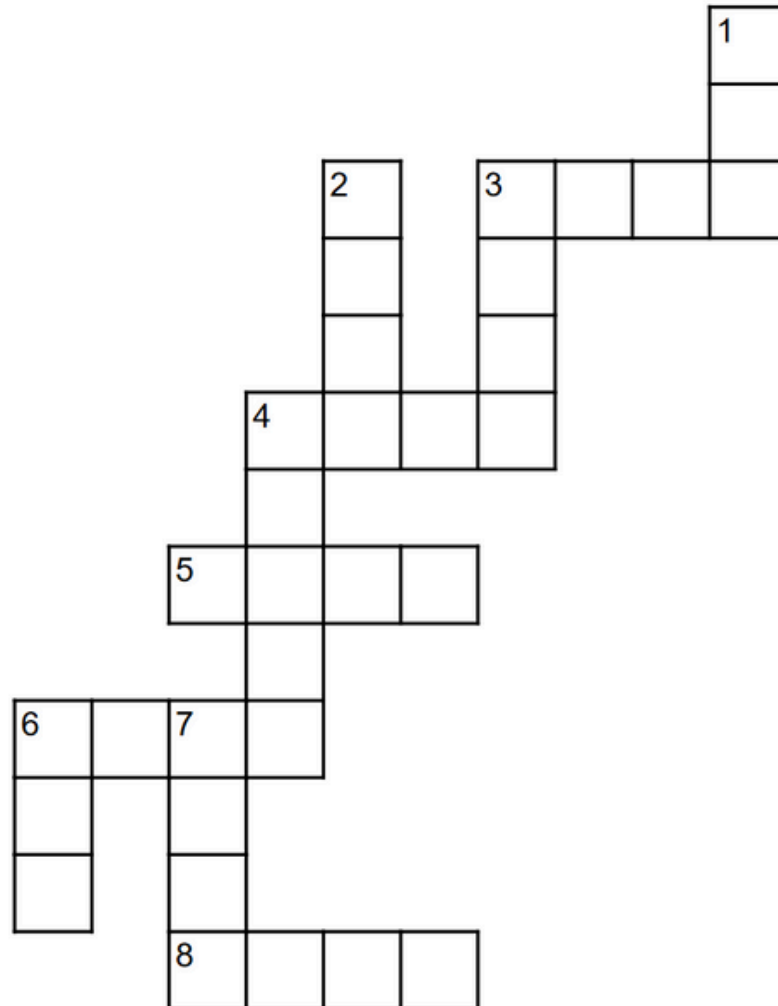

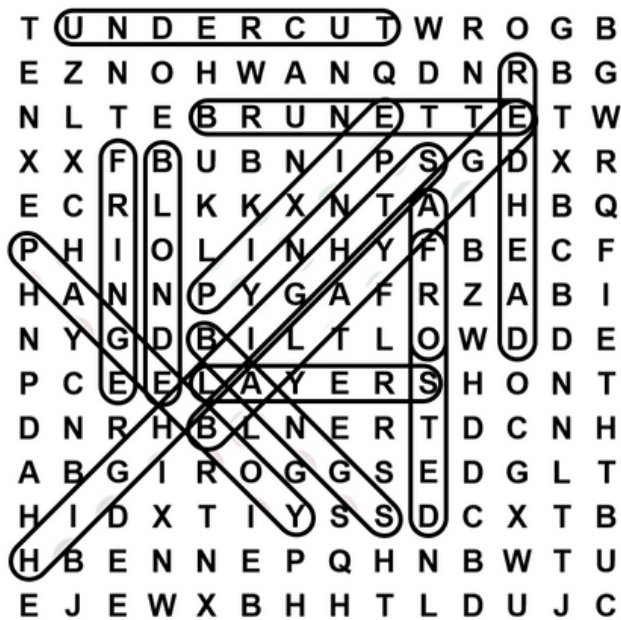

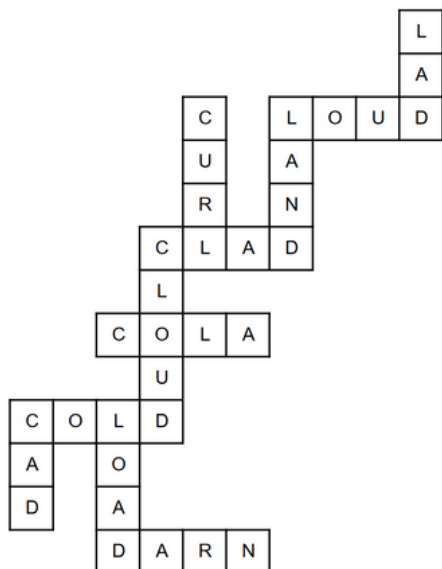
## Trivia Answer: D
