On America Recycles Day, the National Recycling Coalition encourages you to recycle and buy recycled products to reduce waste stream material. In America, about 80% of what is thrown away could be recycled. For example, a television can run for 3 hours using the energy saved by recycling just one can. Approximately 1 billion trees' worth of paper is discarded every year in the U.S., while every month, Americans throw away enough glass bottles and jars to fill a giant skyscraper! On average, it costs \$30 per ton to recycle trash, \$50 to send it to a landfill, and \$65 to \$75 to incinerate it. To celebrate this day, recycle as much as you can, donate items instead of discarding them, and encourage your local, state, and federal governments to promote waste reduction programs. 




