A Talking Statue of Liberty?

In the 1870s, while the Statue of Liberty was being built in France, Thomas Edison, the inventor of the phonograph and light bulb, proposed installing a giant phonograph inside the statue so that it could speak. Edison's idea was to have the statue give speeches that could be heard as far away as Manhattan and New Jersey. He also envisioned the statue as a dynamic figure that could report the weather or speak to the masses, rather than just a silent symbol of freedom. However, the idea was ultimately rejected.

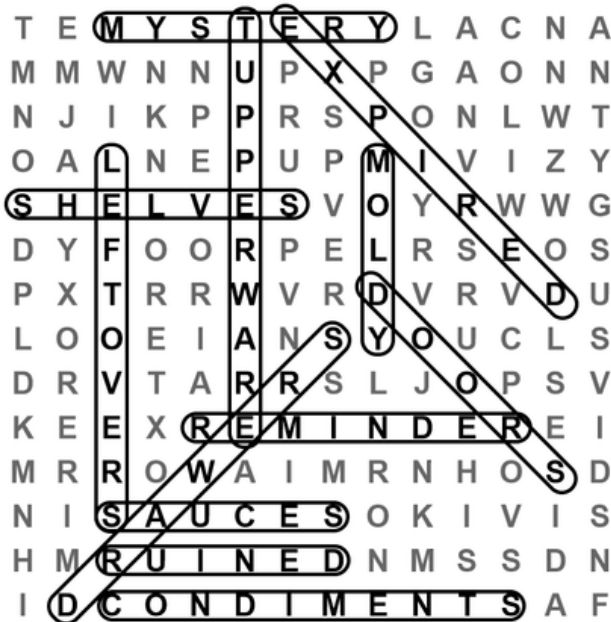


SOLUTIONS
