It was in December 1891 that Dr. Naismith invented basketball after being challenged by his boss to come up with a fair and non-aggressive game that could be played indoors during the cold Massachusetts winter.

Today in History



In 1901, inventor and businessman King C. Gillette started selling disposable safety razor blades. His invention revolutionized shaving and led to the creation of The Gillette Safety Razor Company, which sold 51 razors in 1903 and reached 450,000 razors and 70 million blades by 1914.




DID YOU KNOW? Snow Crop

John I. Moone founded Snow Crop Marketers in 1945 to sell frozen fruits and vegetables. Snow Crop was the first to sell frozen orange concentrate on a national scale. Snow Crop opened retail markets for orange juice concentrate in New York and Philadelphia in 1946. The company's orange juice supplier was Vacuum Foods Corp., which later produced juice under its own Minute Maid label. Minute Maid purchased Snow Crop in late 1954.




