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DID YOU KNOW? Canyon Project to Iconic Landmark

The Hoover Dam, originally known as the Boulder Canyon Project, was later called the Black Canyon Project before being referred to as the Boulder Dam. It was officially named the Hoover Dam in honor of President Herbert Hoover, amidst controversy due to his unpopularity during the Great Depression. It wasn't until 12 years later that a House Resolution passed to formalize the name.



Use the following conversation prompts to start a discussion with friends or family! You may also use the provided lines to answer the questions on your own if you prefer.


Do you enjoy watching the Olympics? Which is your favorite Winter Olympics or Summer Ollympics?
