DID YOU KNOW? Insects to Innovation

Before homeowners used varnishes and polyurethane finishes for waxing their hardwood floors, they used bugs. Specifically, a secretion from the lac bug of India and Thailand, which when dissolved in alcohol creates liquid shellac, the go-to floor finish throughout the Western world in the 19th and early 20th centuries. It would be replaced by nitrocellulose lacquer by the 1930s, but before that bugs kept floors shiny.

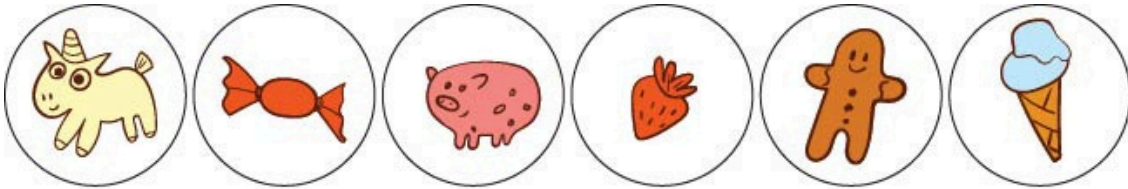
