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


DID YOU KNOW? Penguins' Misunderstood Legacy

The birds we call penguins aren't actually penguins. The term originally referred to the great auk, which went extinct over 180 years ago. Today's penguins belong to the Spheniscidae family, while great auks are part of the Alcidae family. Sailors named them penguins due to their similar appearance. Great auks lived in the North Atlantic but were hunted to extinction because of their appeal as food and the careless treatment they received from humans.
