



Porthole



Materials:



- Cardboard box (or paper plate, cut out center)
- Bottle caps
- Gold spray paint
- Craft paint or construction paper

- Utility knife
- Hot glue gun & glue
- Wax paper

Instructions:

1. First cut the rings the approximate size of portholes out of cardboard.
2. Use a hot glue gun to glue plastic bottle caps on the cardboard rings as faux bolts.
3. Spray paint the cardboard or paper plate gold.
4. Then cut wax paper to size and tape it to the back of the circle. This gives a faux glass look.
5. Make sure spray paint is dry before taping on the wax paper.
6. Then paint the back of the wax paper with thinned acrylic paint (just dilute with water) a scene of the ocean. All you really need is a horizon line and you could even tape construction paper behind the wax paper to work just as well.
