### A Little White Castle

White Castle is a popular hamburger restaurant chain in the United States, with 377 locations across 13 states. It was founded on September 13, 1921, in Wichita, Kansas. When it started, its burgers cost only five cents, a price that lasted until 1929. Then, the price increased slightly to 10 cents, which held until 1949. In 2014, Time magazine named the White Castle slider "The Most Influential Burger of All Time," highlighting its impact on fast food.

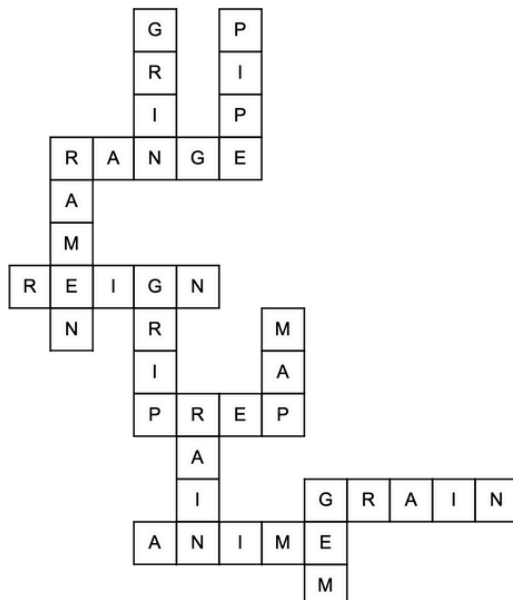
## Trivia Answer: A
