## DID YOU KNOW?

### Mother Vinegar

Vinegar doesn't expire and is a self-preserving fermented product. It's created when yeast consumes sugars, produces alcohol, and is fermented by Acetobacter bacteria to form vinegar. While it can become hazy or develop sediment, including a gelatinous "mother," these changes don't mean it's spoiled. Vinegar mothers can be used to create new batches, and vinegar typically doesn't need refrigeration due to its acidity.

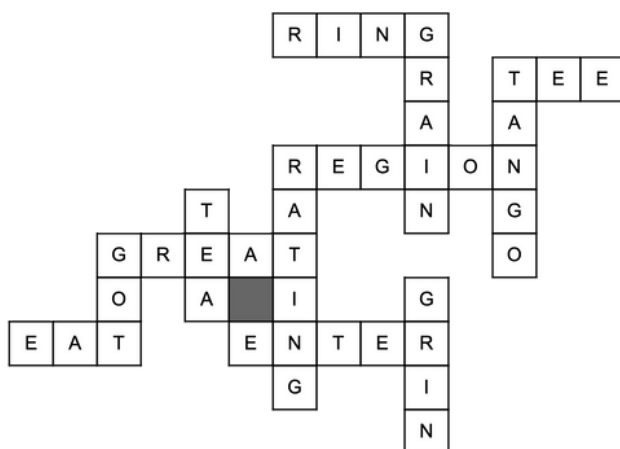
## Trivia Answer: A.

Your epiglottis protects your ability to breathe by protecting your larynx (voice box). It keeps food and liquid from getting into your respiratory system.

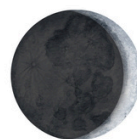

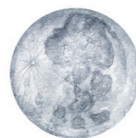
