The lyrics are from an early-19th-century English poem, "The Star" in *Rhymes for the Nursery* by Jane and her sister Ann Taylor (1782–1866) in London in 1806. The melody is French from "Ah! vous dirai-je, Maman", which was published in 1761 and arranged by several composers, including Mozart.




