Lincoln and Shields: Duel Avoided

Before becoming president, Abraham Lincoln clashed with Illinois state auditor James Shields. Lincoln wrote satirical letters about Shields, which sparked a feud. After failing to resolve their differences, they agreed to duel, but their assistants intervened. Instead of fighting, Lincoln retracted his letters. Both men continued their political careers, with Shields serving as a senator and Union general, while Lincoln became president. Their decision to forgo the duel contributed to pivotal moments in U.S. history.
