National Tax Deadline Day

The current tax deadline is April 15, but it hasn't always been that way. The United States re-enacted an income tax with the 16th Amendment in 1913. At that time, the filing deadline was March 1. In 1918, the deadline was changed to March 15, and then in 1955, the filing deadline was moved to April 15th. In some years, more significant extensions have been granted by the Federal Government because of extenuating circumstances like natural disasters. To observe National Tax Day, the best way is to complete and file your taxes.

It is important to save a copy of your tax return in a safe place. You can also give a shout-out to your tax preparer and quote Benjamin Franklin, who once said, "Nothing is certain but death and taxes."

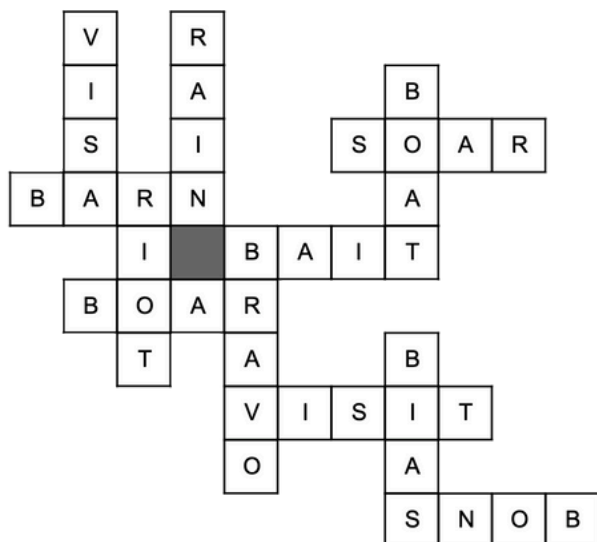
Trivia Answer: C.
