### "Star Spangled Banner" wasn't an immediate hit

"The Star-Spangled Banner," along with "Hail Columbia" and "Yankee Doodle," gained prominence after the War of 1812. During the Civil War, it became an anthem for Union troops and grew in popularity, leading President Woodrow Wilson to designate it for military ceremonies in 1916. After 40 previous attempts, Congress finally passed a measure on March 3, 1931, formally designating "The Star-Spangled Banner" as the United States' national anthem.

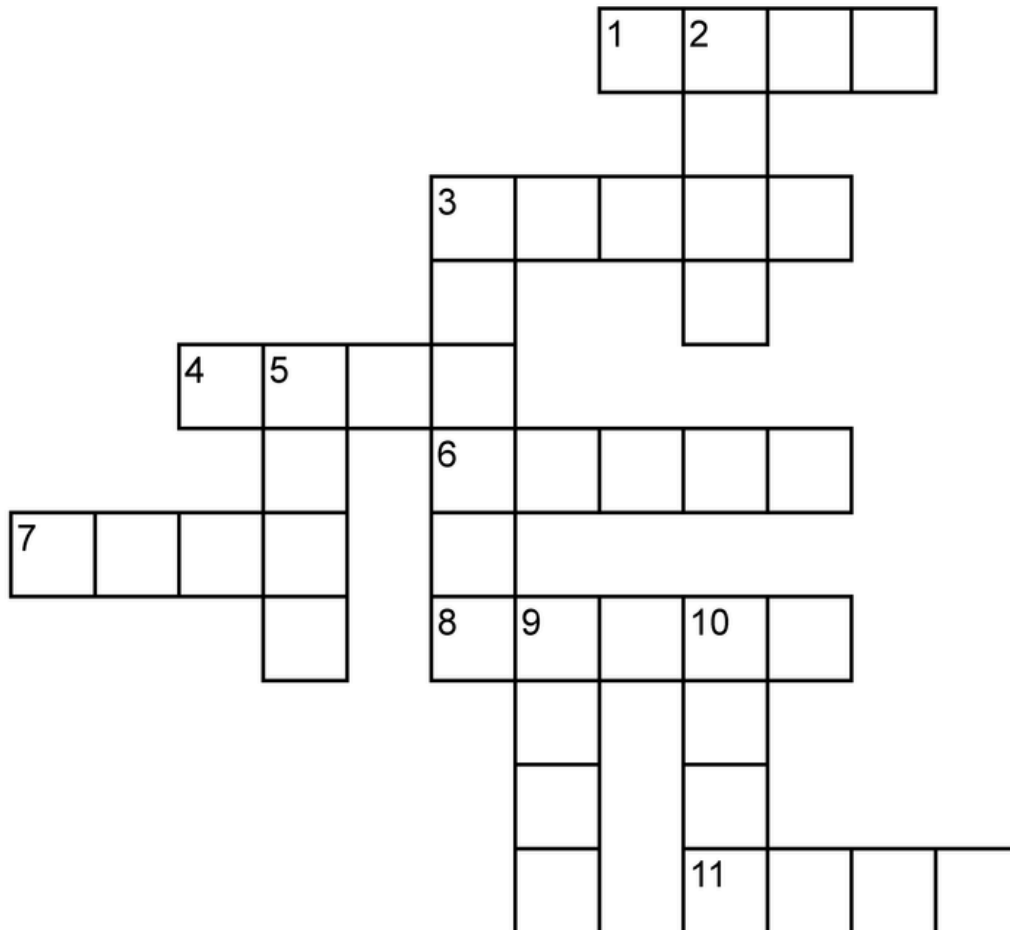

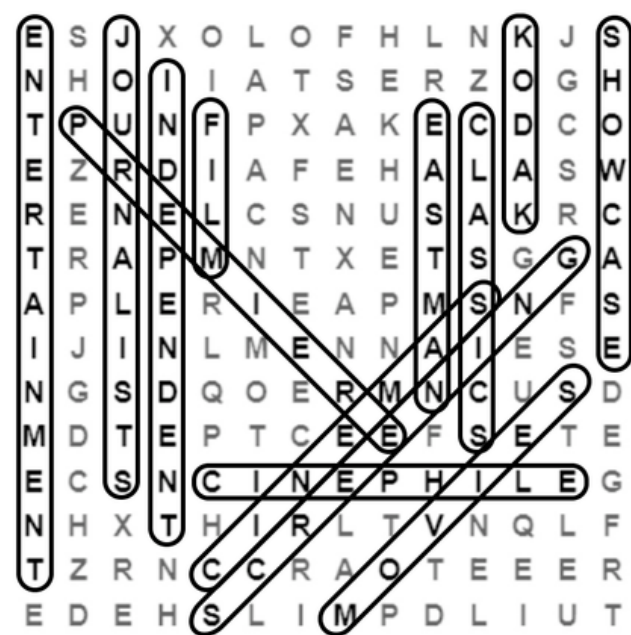

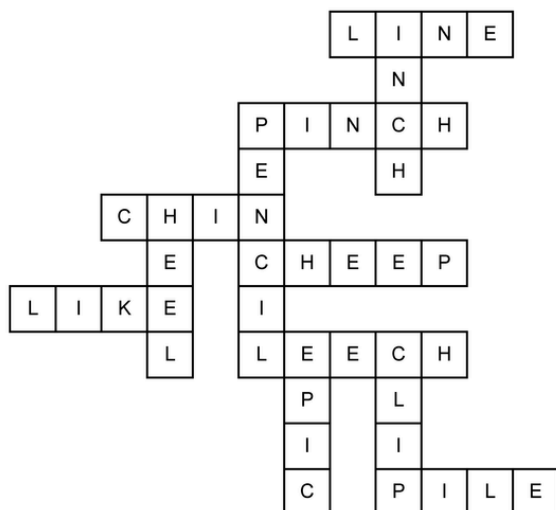
