National Iwo Jima Day

On February 19, 1945, U.S. Marines and the Imperial Army of Japan squared off in the Battle of Iwo Jima. Over a five-week period, nearly 7,000 Marines perished as the Japanese army used the mountainous landscape and jungles to their advantage by setting up camouflaged artillery positions, which made life extremely difficult for the Marines. Their persistence paid off, however, as the Marines eventually got the upper hand in the battle, emerging victorious against all odds. Iwo Jima Day is a time for all Americans to pay tribute to those soldiers who were lost in what was a horrific battle, as well as the others who proudly served in one of the bloodiest events of World War II.

DID YOU KNOW?

A Hairy History

Long before modern razors, shaving dates back to the Stone Age, about 100,000 years ago. During this cold period, facial hair became a liability, as long beards could freeze against the skin. Early methods were primitive; people used seashells to pull hair out and later obsidian shards for a more effective shave. By ancient Egypt (2686-2181 BCE), copper razors emerged, sometimes adorned with decorative designs, indicating that these early shaving methods persisted longer than one might think.

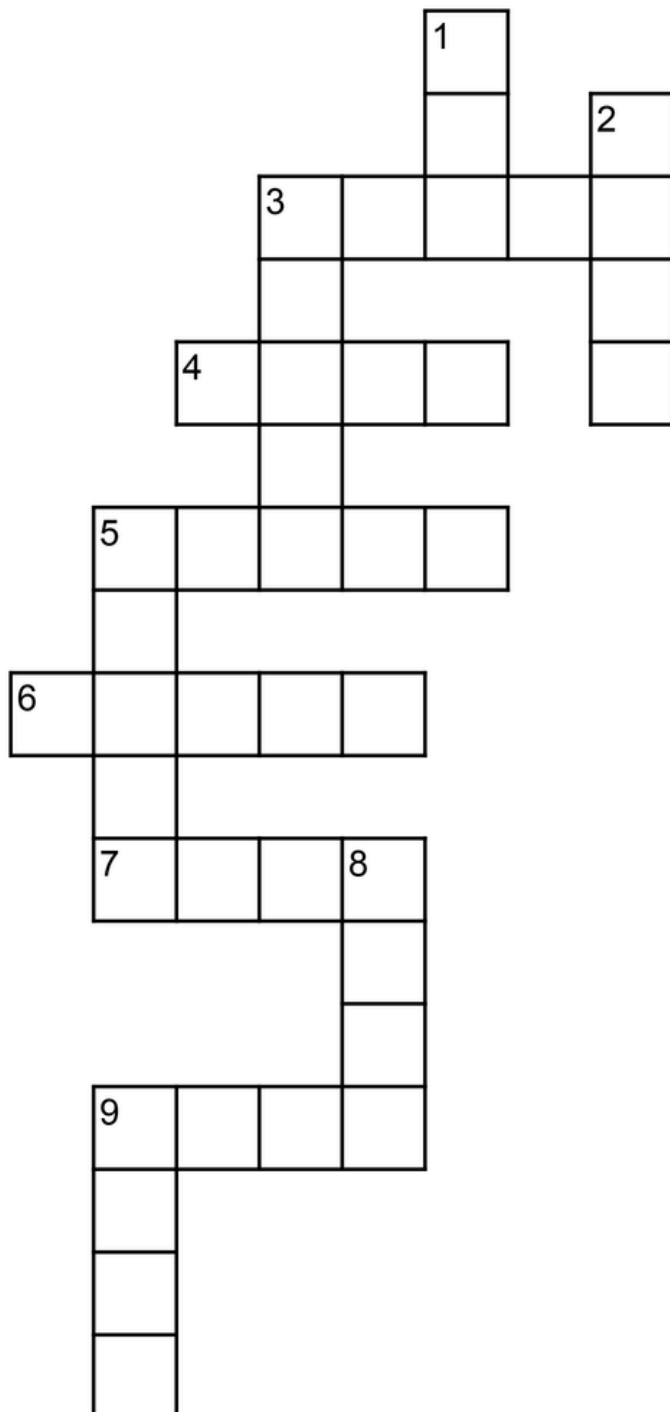

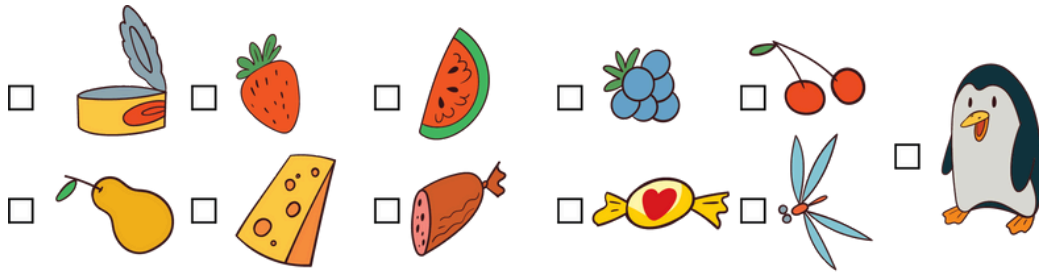
