Wanderlust of the Greats

In 1915, famed figures Thomas Edison, Henry Ford, John Burroughs, and Harvey Firestone formed the Vagabonds, embarking on summer camping trips across the U.S. Their adventures, which included excursions to the Everglades and Southern California, captivated the public and even attracted President Warren G. Harding in 1921 and Calvin Coolidge in 1924. However, increasing public attention led to the disbanding of the Vagabonds later that year.

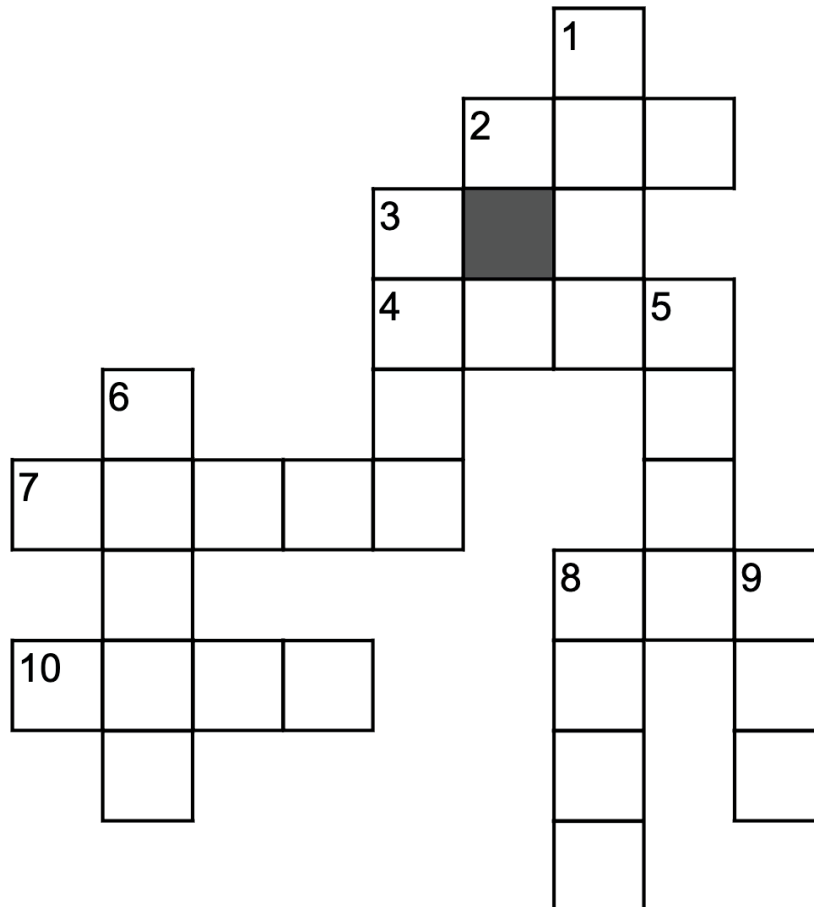

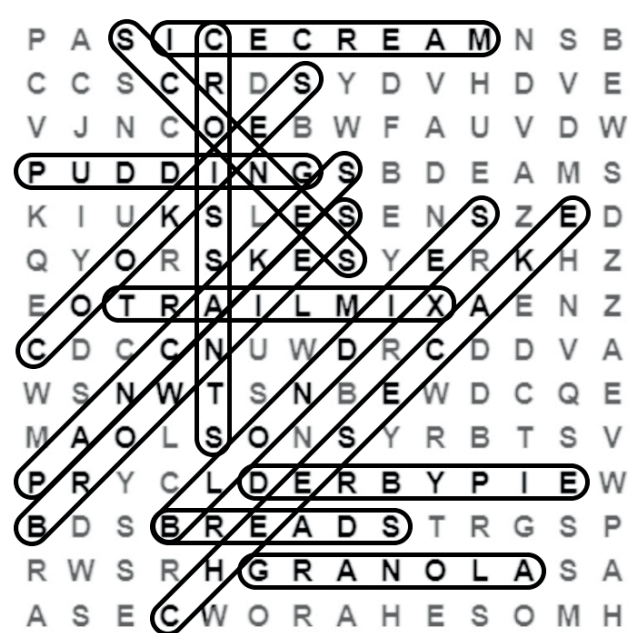




SOLUTIONS
