Venomous caterpillars, though only 2% of species, have unique venoms that may lead to valuable medical discoveries. While snake and scorpion venoms are well-studied, many venomous animals, including caterpillars, remain underresearched. Some caterpillar venoms can cause severe health issues, making them significant public health concerns. Advancements in molecular biology could help explore these venoms, potentially unveiling new drug candidates and informing treatments for pain and other conditions.






