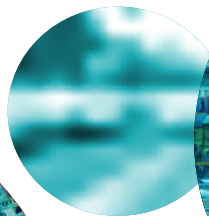

FORM OF GOVERNMENT: Federal Republic of Germany

POPULATION: 83,783,942

GEOGRAPHY: on the northern edge of the Alps, with local rivers Isar and Wurm. Munich is situated in the Northern Alpine Foreland.



KNOWN FOR:

Munich, Bavaria's capital, is home to centuries-old buildings and numerous museums. The city is known for its annual Oktoberfest celebration and its beer halls, including the famed Hofbräuhaus, founded in 1589. In the Altstadt (Old Town), central Marienplatz square contains landmarks such as Neo-Gothic Neues Rathaus (town hall), with a popular glockenspiel show that chimes and reenacts stories from the 16th century.

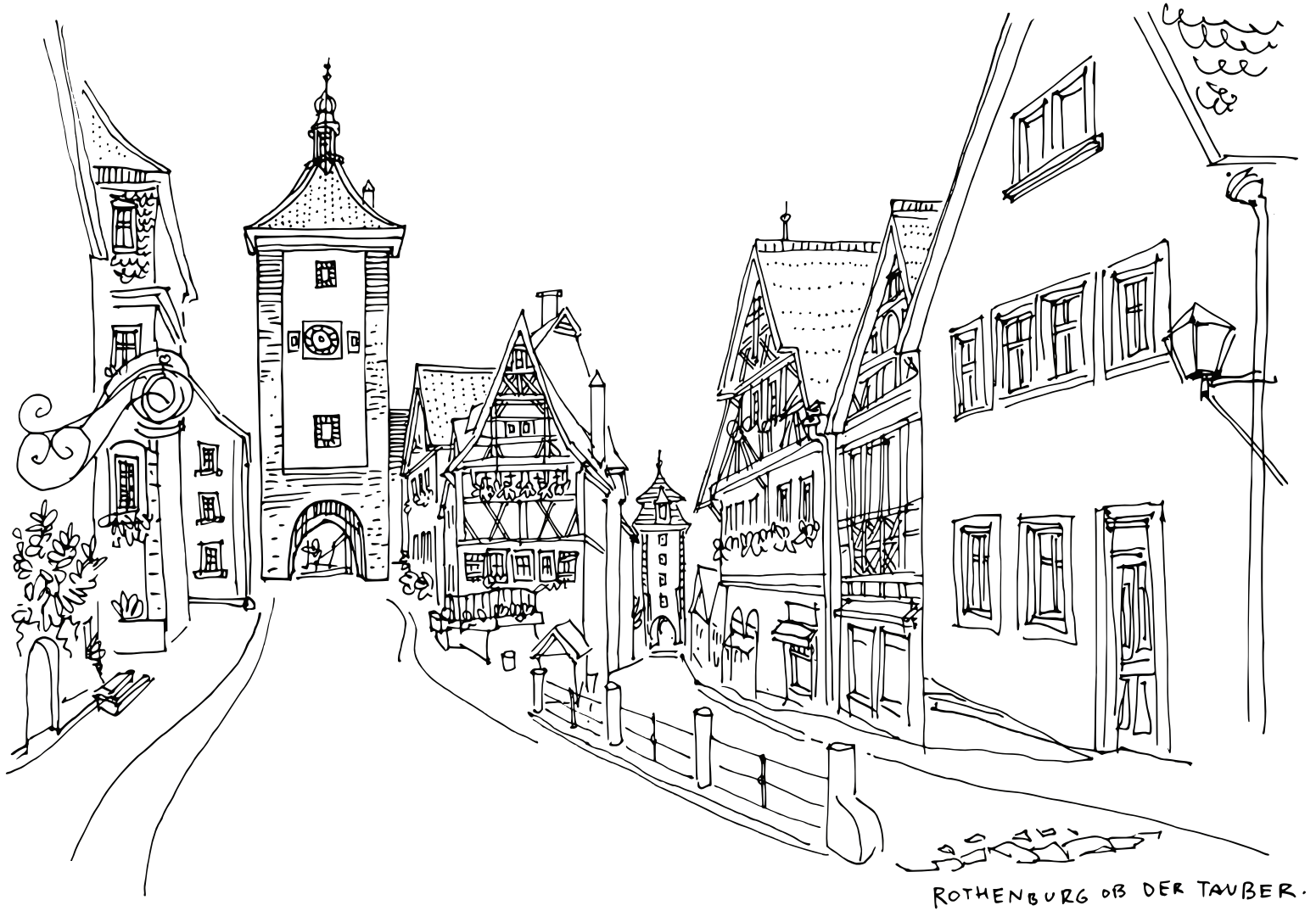

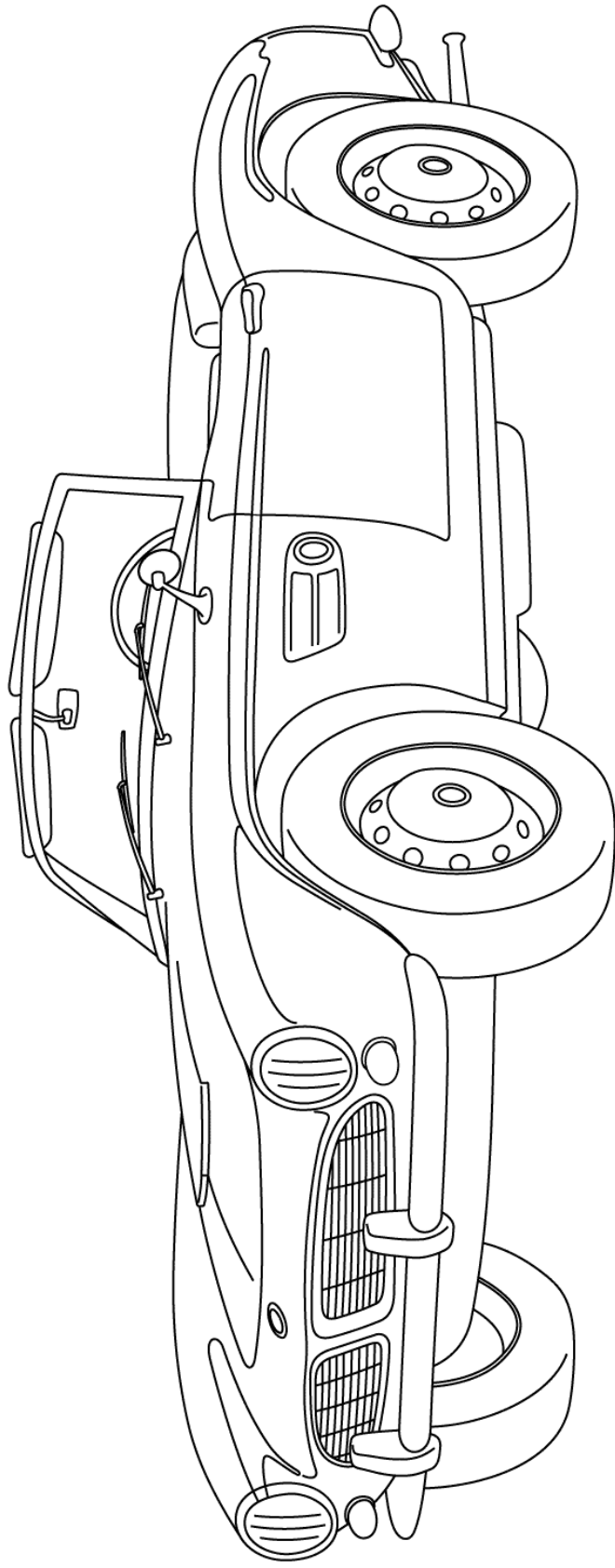

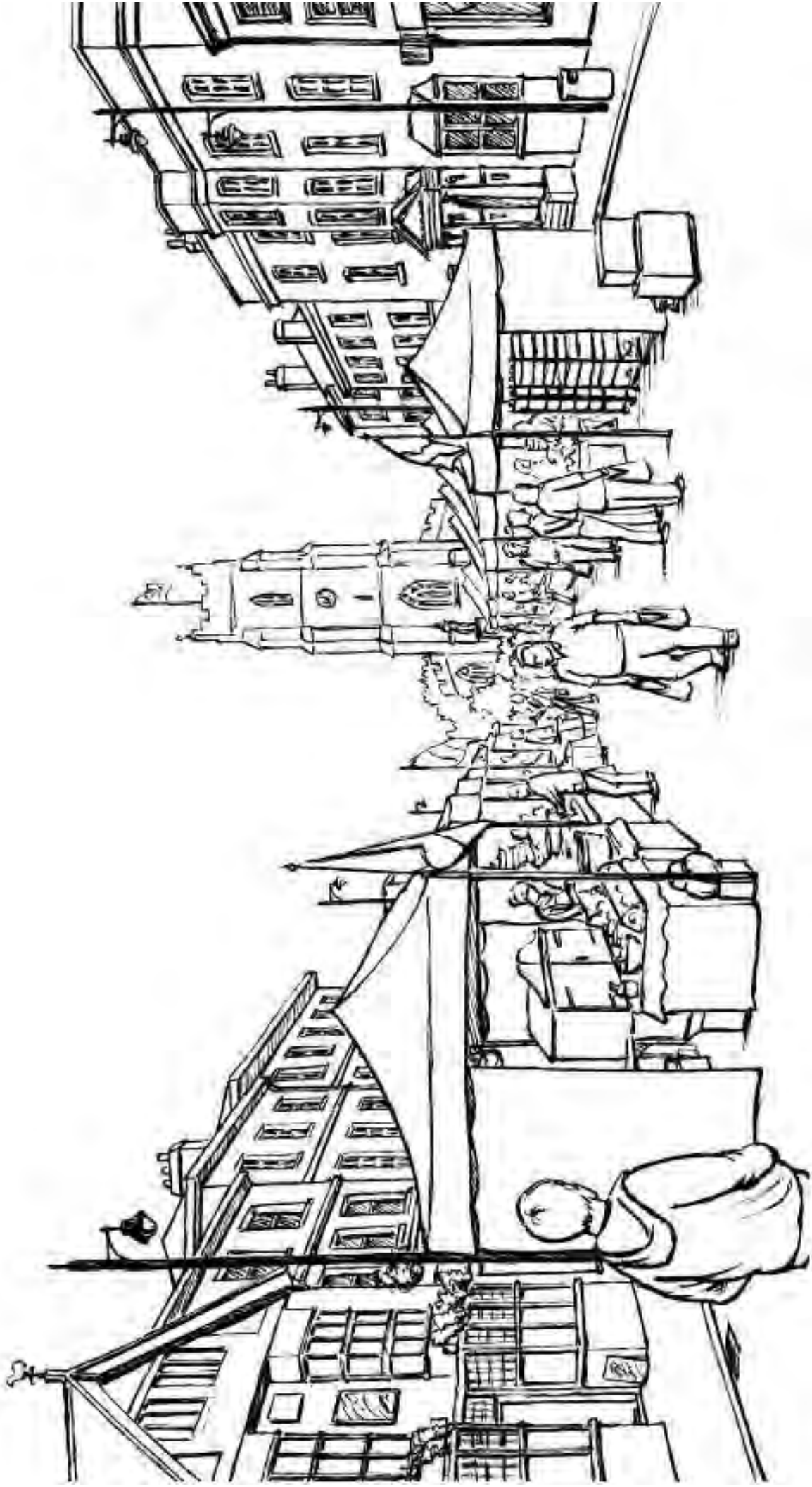
GENERAL FACTS:

- There are more than 80 museums in Munich
- Munich is further north than any major US city (excluding Alaska).
- There are over 60 beer gardens in Munich.
- The major streets of the old town of Munich were pedestrianized for the Olympics in 1972 and have stayed pedestrian only ever since.
- The famous Oktoberfest is held here every September until ending in October.
- There are six major breweries in Munich: Augustiner Bräu, Hofbräu, Löwenbräu, Hacker-Pschorr Bräu, Spaten-Franziskaner Bräu, and Paulaner Brauerei.
- Beer is considered as a food in Bavaria officially.
- Home of the 1972 Olympics

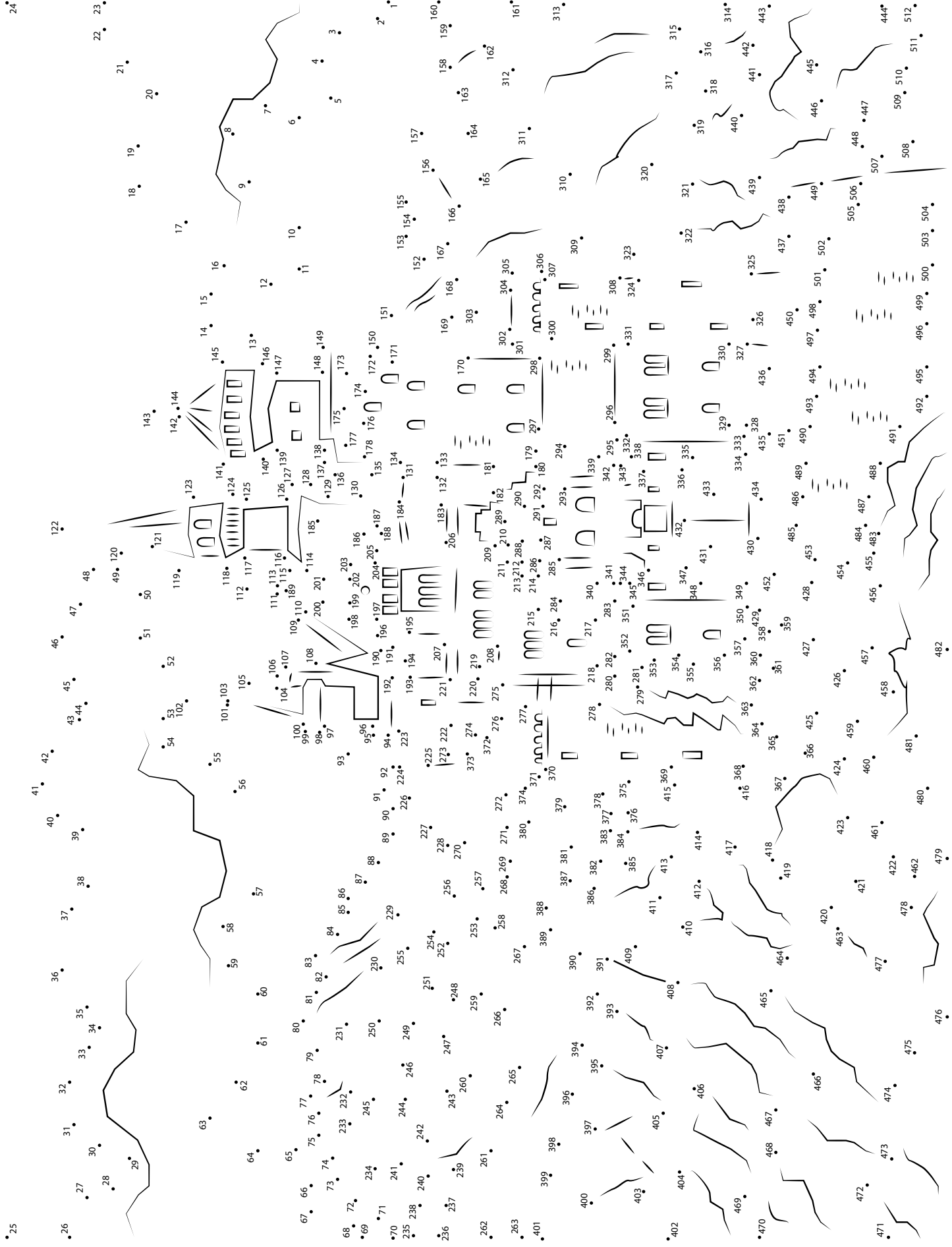

Munich is the birthplace of one of the most famous car brands in the world – BMW. The brand has its own museum, where you can learn about the history of the company, find retro models; and see future projects.



If it wasn't for Monks, the capital of Bavaria wouldn't be founded, as in the 12th century the Duke of Bavaria allowed monks to start a marketplace. Actually, not only monks have influenced the formation of the city, which is depicted in its name, München (in German) comes from the word Mönch (monk); but also it became a symbol and is even represented on the city's coat of arms.¹
