DID YOU KNOW? Motor City Miracle

Founded by Berry Gordy in 1959, Motown Record Corporation emerged from Tamla Records, paying homage to Detroit's automotive legacy—its “Mo” stands for “Motor.” The label blended R&B, soul, and pop, launching superstars like the Supremes, Stevie Wonder, and Marvin Gaye. Motown not only redefined American music but also became one of the most successful Black-owned businesses, breaking down racial barriers and achieving immense popularity with just an \$800 investment.
