Whether you visit a park, a botanical garden, or sit quietly in the shade of a tree, spend some time with nature and give meditation a try.




Today in History

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


DID YOU KNOW? The Hemisphere Champion

The hemispheres divide the world into four sections: the equator marks the Northern and Southern hemispheres, while the prime meridian divides the Western and Eastern hemispheres. 






SOLUTIONS
