Overcompensating for his stature, he became obsessed with collecting towering soldiers, often buying or commandeering them, even scouting large babies. Frederick showcased his troops to foreign dignitaries, treating them like curiosities, and famously commanded parades accompanied by a live bear, further emphasizing his unique obsession.




