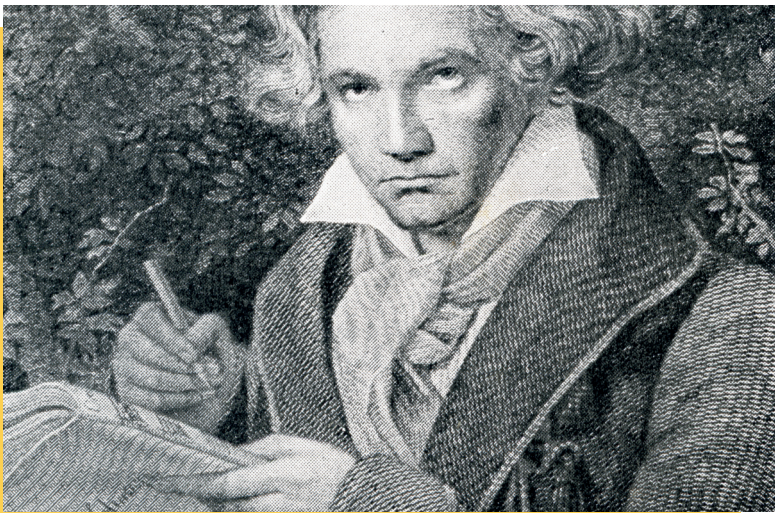


Today in History

Ludwig van Beethoven began losing his hearing in his late 20s, leading to severe depression while he composed for another three decades. Along with this, he suffered gastrointestinal ailments throughout his life. After his death at 56, attributed to pneumonia and organ damage, historians proposed various theories about his condition, from lead poisoning to celiac disease.
