Monopoly's properties are named after locations in Atlantic City, New Jersey, due to a regional version created by Ruth Hoskins. After learning an earlier version of the game in Indianapolis, she adapted it with friends in Atlantic City. One of these friends, Charles Todd, introduced this version to Charles Darrow. The placement of properties on the game board reflected Atlantic City's actual property values at the time, making the game locally relevant.

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






SOLUTIONS
