With an increase in kindness and tolerance, communities become more open and accepting of diverse cultures, religions, and lifestyles, which can lead to increased collaboration and creativity.

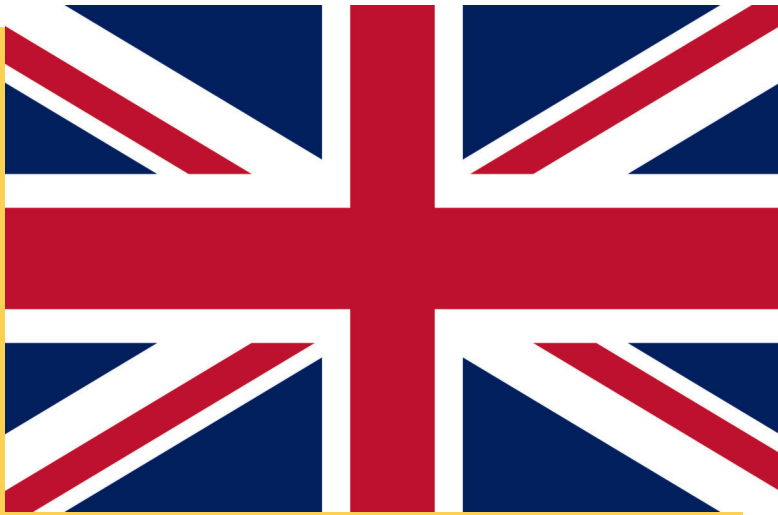


Today in History

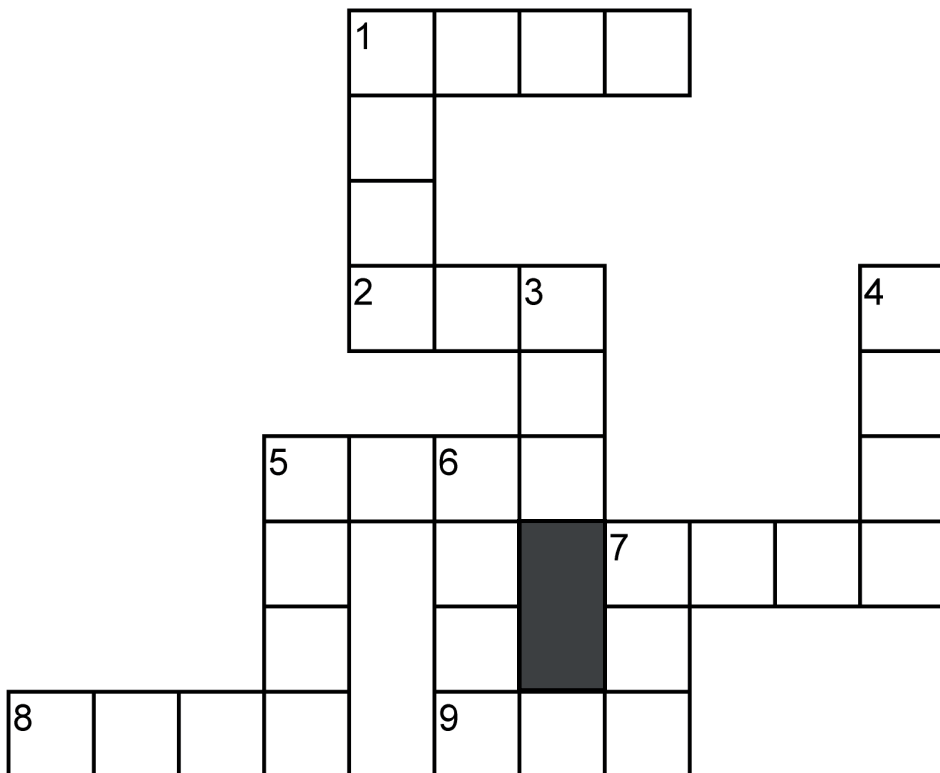

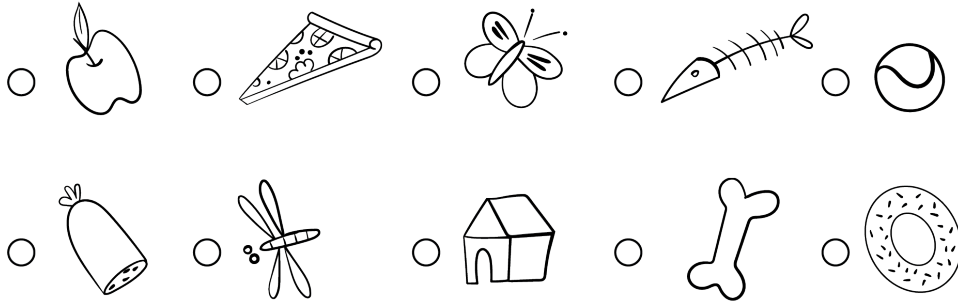

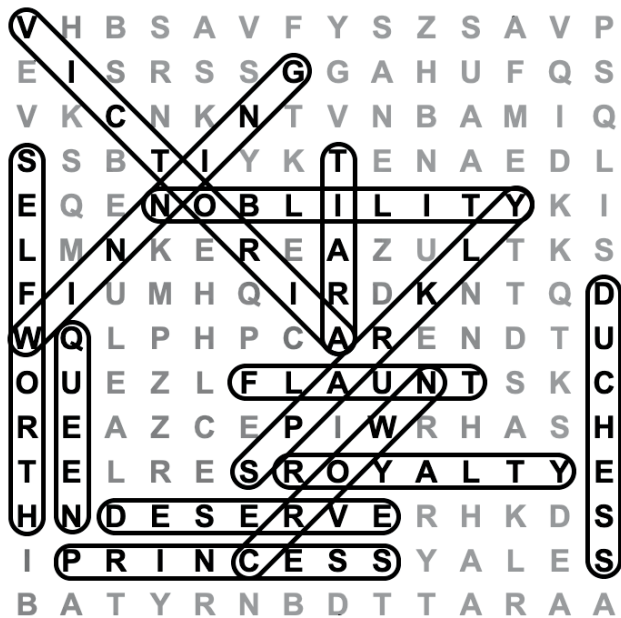
