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## DID YOU KNOW? Istanbul's First Subway

Istanbul's Tünel, completed in 1875, is the world's second-oldest subway system, part of a broader public transport network that included ferries and trams. Proposed by French engineer Eugène-Henri Gavand, it features a 1,820-foot tunnel with two tracks. Initially, two wooden trains operated simultaneously, powered by a stationary steam engine. This engine was replaced by electricity in 1971, and the Tünel continues to serve the city today.
