Babe Ruth made history in 1930 by becoming the first athlete to earn more than the U.S. president, whose salary was \$75,000 during that time. Ruth signed a contract with the New York Yankees worth \$80,000 a year, surpassing President Herbert Hoover's pay. When asked about making more than the president, Ruth famously stated, "Why not? I had a better year than he did." By 1949, other baseball stars matched the president's salary.






