### Fuller Brush Legacy

Founded in 1906 by Alfred C. Fuller, the Fuller Brush Company gained fame through direct-to-door sales, making the "Fuller Brush Man" a cultural icon. Starting with a modest \$75 investment, it quickly grew and surpassed \$1 million in annual sales by 1919, expanding beyond brushes to include various cleaning and household products. After several ownership changes, including acquisition by Sara Lee in 1968, the company now adapts its sales model while continuing to offer a diverse product range.

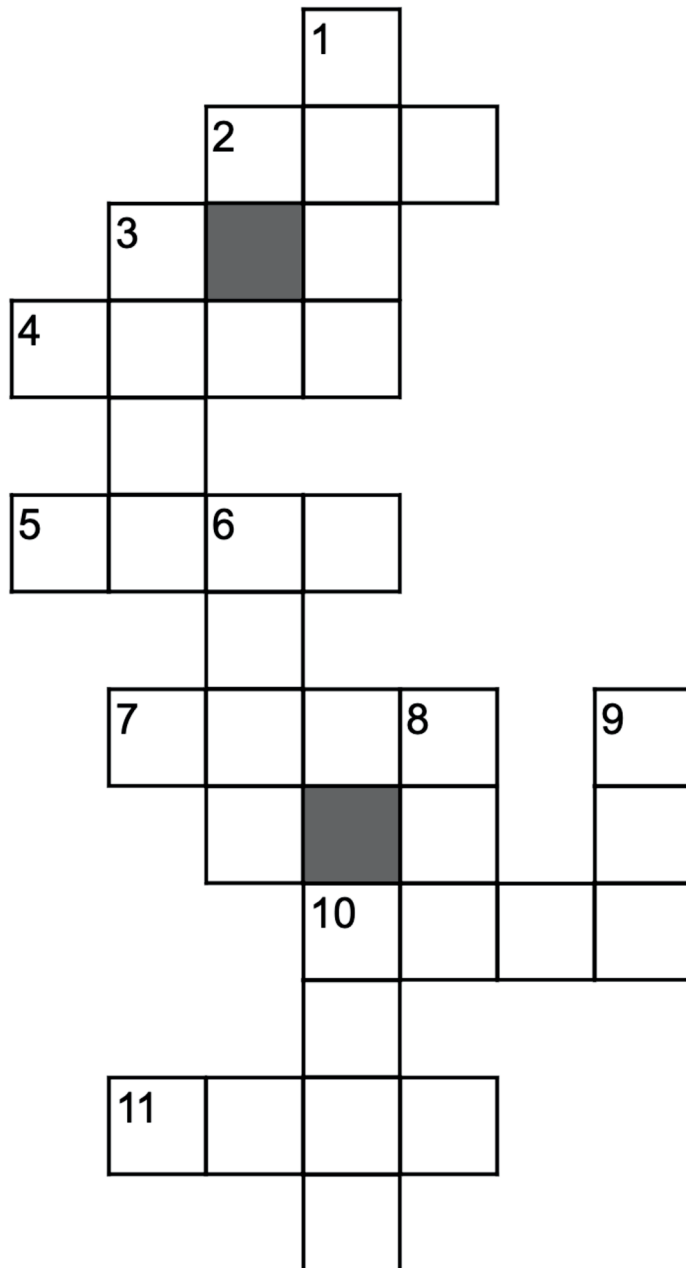

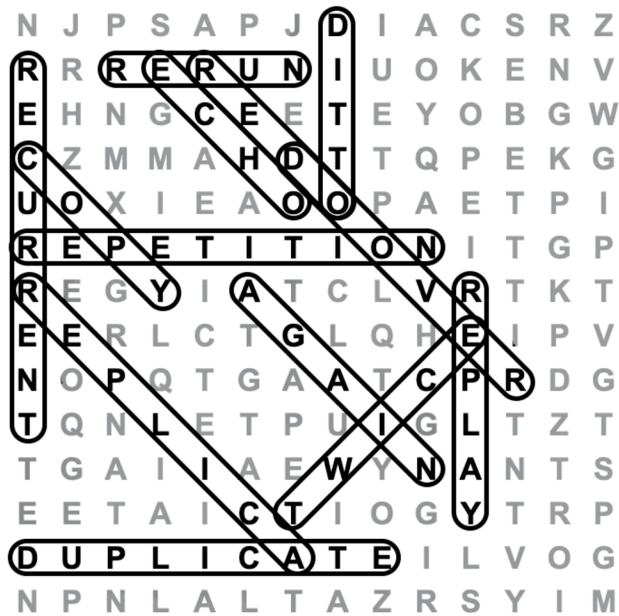

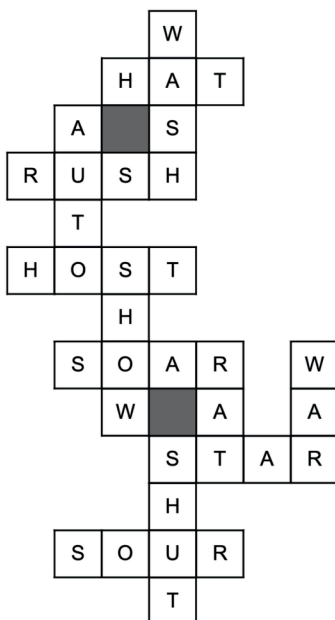
