National Flag Day

"You're a grand ol' flag, you're a high-flying flag, and forever in peace may you wave..." June 14th is the day we honor the Stars and Stripes, the American flag. The U.S. flag represents independence, freedom, and unity and is a strong symbol of American patriotism. Our flag represents the fifty states by featuring 50 white stars on a field of blue in the left upper corner and 13 alternating red and white stripes to correspond to our original Thirteen Colonies.

The field of blue represents perseverance, vigilance, and justice; the red represents valor and bravery; and the white represents purity and innocence. Today, show your patriotism for the United States by honoring our flag.



Today in History

In 1777, the U.S. Continental Congress adopted the Stars & Stripes Flag, designed by American lawyer Francis Hopkinson, who was one of the signers of the Declaration of Independence. In addition to becoming a federal judge, he wrote numerous widely circulated poems and pamphlets.
