In 1971, "Tapestry" by Carole King hit #1 on the US album charts and stayed there for 15 weeks. Inducted into the Songwriters Hall of Fame and twice into the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame, King won four Grammys and was the first female to receive a Library of Congress Gershwin Prize.

Radio Saved the Eiffel Tower

The Eiffel Tower, built by Gustave Eiffel for the 1889 Exposition Universelle, was originally intended to be demolished after 20 years. To secure its future, Eiffel demonstrated the tower's usefulness by transmitting a radio signal from its tip to the Panthéon in 1898. By 1908, it had become a significant radio tower, intercepting messages during World War I. Today, it still hosts various radio antennas.

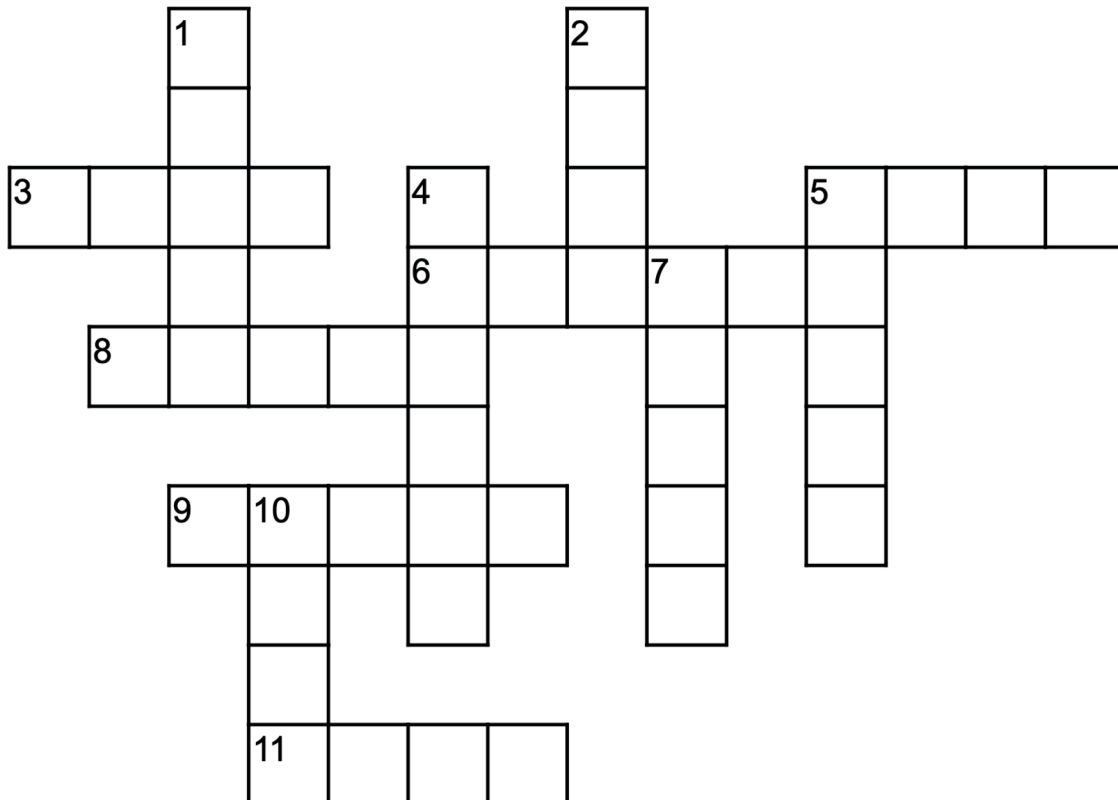

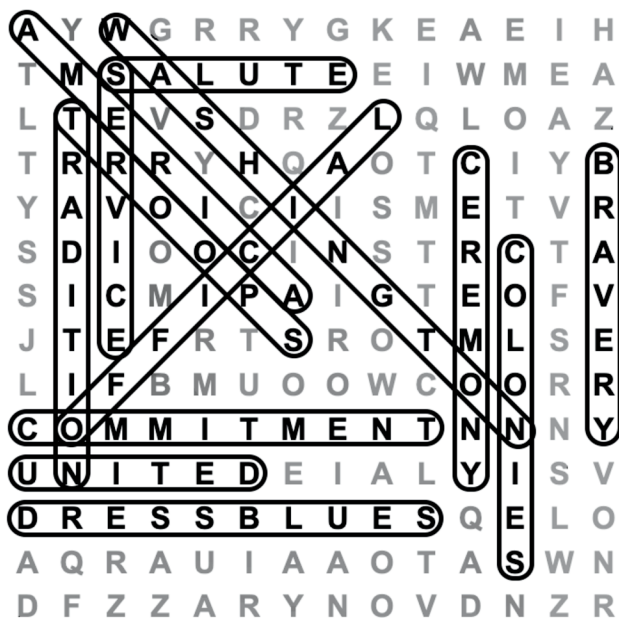

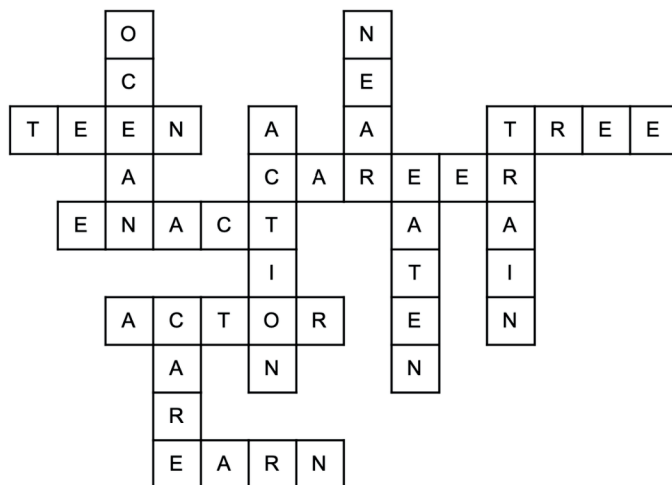
Trivia Answer: C.
