Why Oz?

L. Frank Baum may have drawn inspiration for the name "Oz" from an unexpected source: a cabinet letter file on his desk. In a 1903 interview with the St. Louis Republic, he recounted how he was pondering a title for his story when his eyes landed on the cabinet's gilt letters: A-G, H-N, and O-Z. "Oz it at once became," he said. Some speculate he was joking, but the mystical connection between furniture and fantasy endures.
