Pioneer of Nonreflective Glass

Katharine Burr Blodgett, born in 1898, was a groundbreaking physicist and the first woman scientist at General Electric. She invented nonreflective glass, enhancing visibility for filmmakers and military applications during World War II. Her thin coatings improved periscopes, spy cameras, and microscopes, revolutionizing various fields. Blodgett earned a doctorate from Cambridge and held multiple patents, including a method to de-ice airplane wings.






