## U.S. Coast Guard Day

U.S. Coast Guard Day honors the military branch that protects our waters and shorelines. On August 4, 1790, the Revenue Cutter Service was created by the U.S. Congress. Congress authorized the construction of ten cutters. These ships were built to enforce U.S. tariff laws. The Revenue Cutter Service was the predecessor of the U.S. Coast Guard. The name “Coast Guard” was first used in 1915.

The U.S. Defense Department suggests that this day is largely an internal celebration for all Coast Guard personnel and their families, past and present. But we’d like to encourage everyone to honor the brave members of this important branch of the military, who are now playing an even more extensive role in Homeland Security to protect our country.

In 2021, the late Tony Bennett celebrated his 95th birthday with Lady Gaga in the first of two “Farewell” performances at Radio City Music Hall in New York City. He sold over 50 million records, won 20 Grammy Awards, was awarded a Kennedy Center Honor in 2005, and retired in 2021.

### Cloth Napkins

The first paper napkins appeared in ancient China, used with tea cups. Before that, cultures like the Romans used finger bowls. In the Middle Ages, people often used sleeves, but nobles began using separate cloths. This evolved into the cloth napkin we know today, which comes with its etiquette: spread it on your lap, dab at your mouth, and leave it loosely folded on the table when finished.

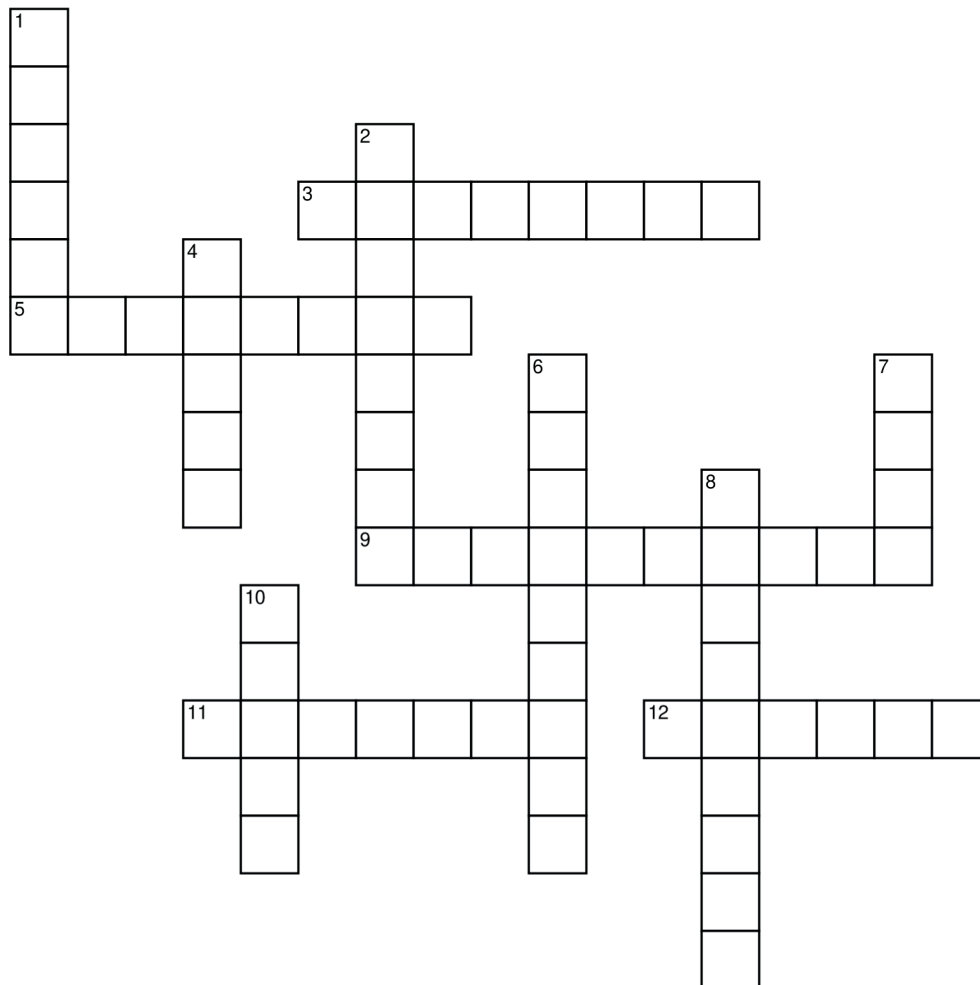
## Helpful Tip:

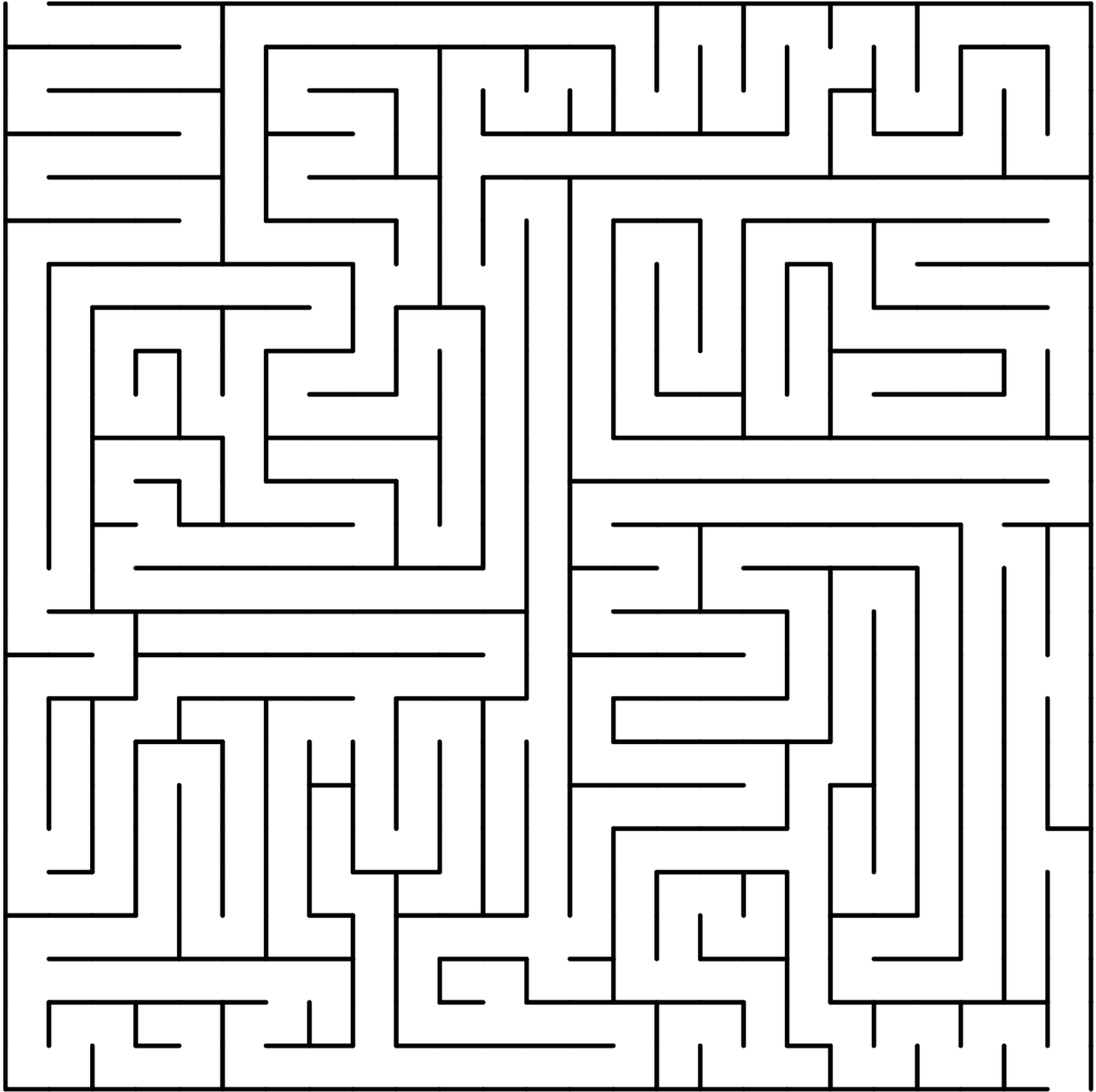
