DID YOU KNOW?

World's Narrowest Street

Spreuerhofstraße in Reutlingen, Germany, claims the title of the world's narrowest street, measuring just 1 foot wide at its tightest point. Created after a 1726 fire, it has become a quirky tourist attraction despite its claustrophobic dimensions and low overhead. Officially recognized in 1820, its future remains uncertain as nearby buildings encroach on its space. If conditions change, it may lose its record to another narrow lane, like England's Parliament Street.




Use the following conversation prompts to start a discussion with friends or family! You may also use the provided lines to answer the questions on your own if you prefer.
