Etch A Sketch Day

The Magic Screen was invented in the late 1950s by Andre Cassagnes and put on the market by the Ohio Art Company on July 12, 1960. It was originally sold for \$2.99, equivalent to around \$26 in today's currency. It had a glass screen that was eventually replaced with plastic. Does this sound familiar? It should! We just know it by a different name: the Etch A Sketch.

Introduced into the National Toy Hall of Fame in 1998, it shouldn't have come as a surprise to anyone that the Etch A Sketch would be named one of the 100 most memorable toys of the 20th century a few years later. This classic toy has delighted generations and is celebrated each year on July 12th.



Today in History



In 1901, Cy Young won his 300th baseball game. With the most wins in Major League Baseball, his total was 511, and he established many pitching records. The Cy Young Award was created to honor him one year after his death and is given to one pitcher per league annually.

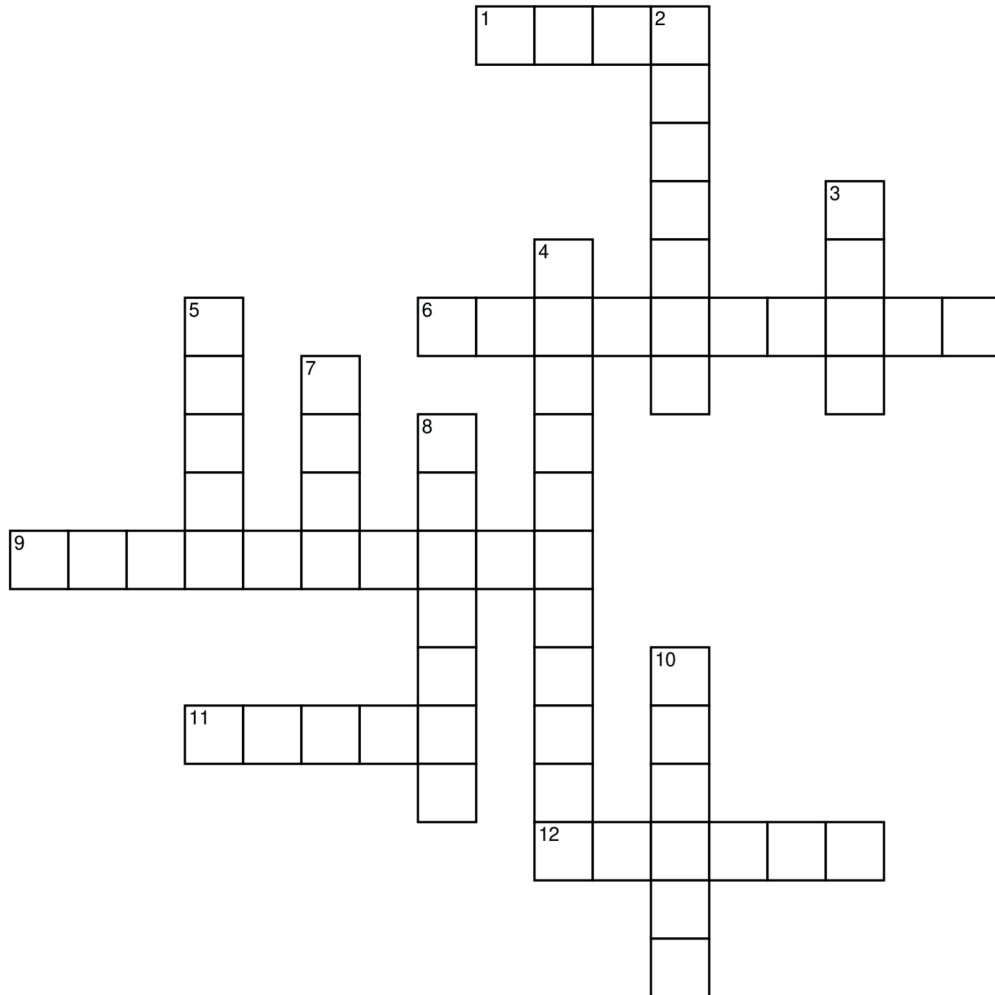

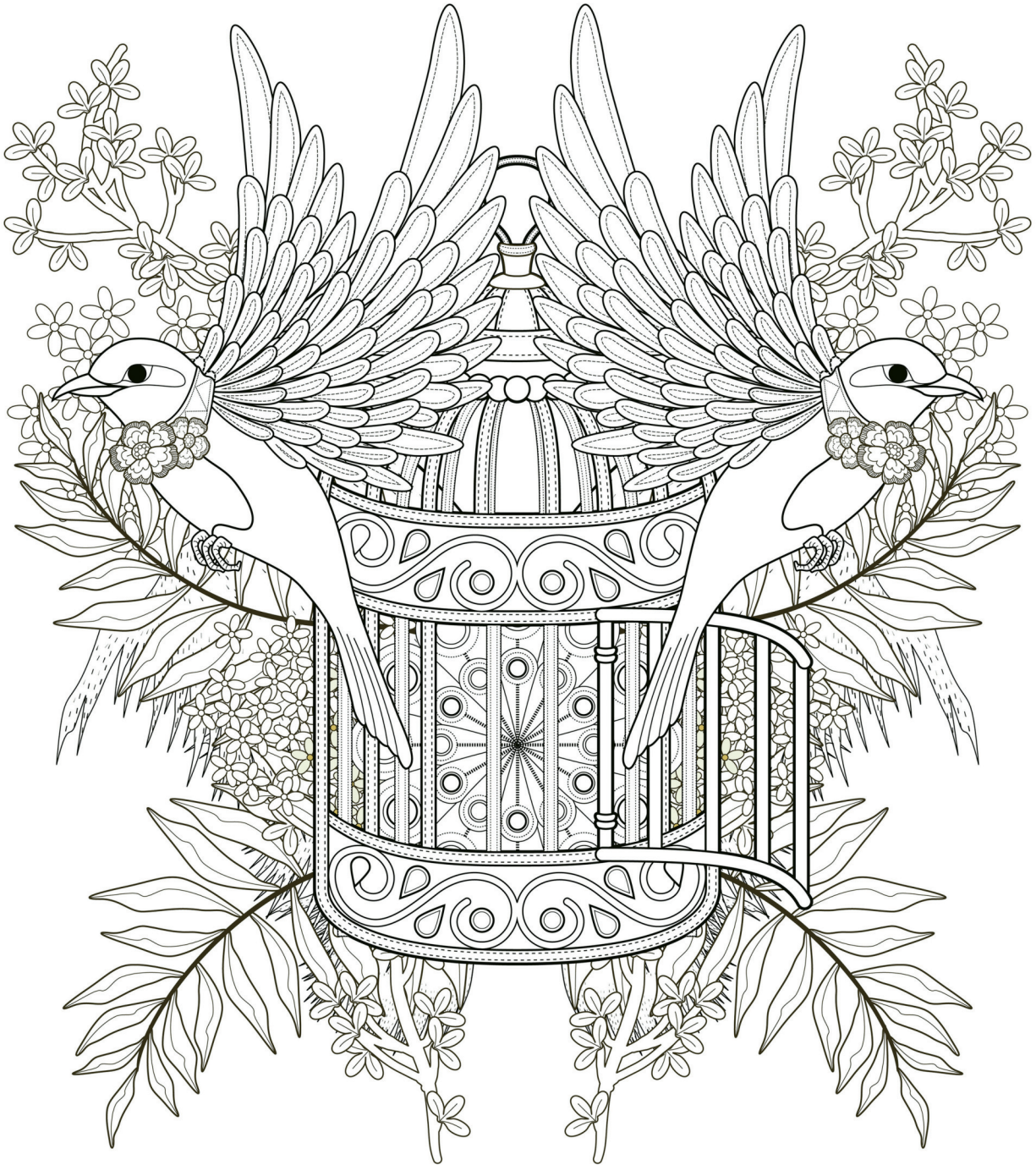
